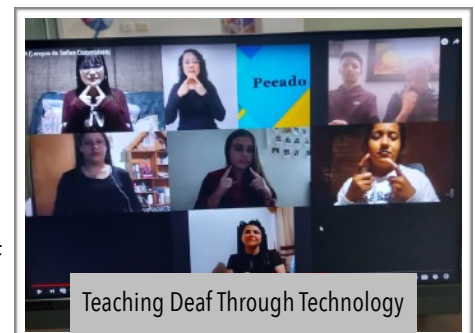


It is with joy that we share what God is doing in His ministry here in the city of Monteria, Colombia. **"And he said to them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature"** (Mark 16:15). By the grace of God, we continue to do the Great Commission through our church. Esneider, Pedro, José, Liliana, Rafael, Lorena, Leonardo, Victor, Tiburcio, and Gustavo received Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior to the glory of God. They are involved in the ministry of personal evangelism. After not being able to meet in person for a while due to local government restrictions and our space being inadequate for the biosafety protocols, God opened the door for us to rent a

farm house on a per-hour basis. We are meeting as a church in this place, having visitors who are hearing the gospel of Christ and are being saved. One example is Elkin and his 11-year-old daughter Mariana.

I want to thank God for my sister Katia Milena's healing. She spent more than ten days in intermediate care in a clinic due to complications from COVID-19. Also, we thank everybody who supported us in prayer for her recovery. God gave me the opportunity to share the gospel with Katia, through social media, while she was in the clinic. She asked Christ to forgive all her sins, and she received Jesus as her Lord and personal Savior; praise and glory to God.

In the ministry of deaf people, several brothers in Christ from two churches here in Colombia are teaching the Colombian Sign Language. This month, one group will finish the first level of language study, and another group will begin. We rejoice because there is yet another group from another church that will also start taking Sign Language classes to reach deaf people for Christ in their community. Our goal is for each local church to train its people to reach to the Deaf in Colombia. There are approximately 500,000 deaf people throughout the country.



We feel so much joy when we see what God is doing in your lives and ministries. Thank you for being faithful to Him. Thank you for being an inspiration and an encouragement to our lives and ministries during this time when the rapture of the church is imminent. May God continue to bless you.

Please, brothers, help us to pray for the following requests: (1) Protection and provision of God for our family, our church, and our country, Colombia. (2) That the strike that has lasted for more than a month, the blockades, violence, and vandalism will end. (3) The situation that has caused the number of cases of infections and deaths from COVID-19 to multiply, due to the vaccination plan against COVID-19 here in Colombia. We need wisdom from God for the salvation of souls.

Thank you very much, brethren, for being a part of God's work here in the city of Montería, Colombia, through your constant prayers to God for us and your financial support. We love you in the Lord, and we pray to the Lord always for you and your ministries.
