SRBC Kumasi, relocates:

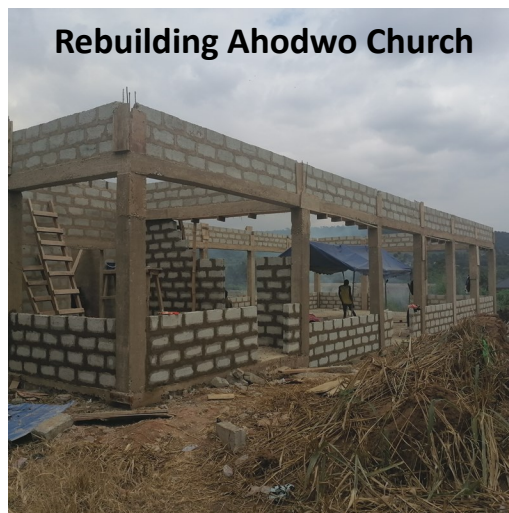
In April, I paid a visit to our church in Kumasi to encourage them. This church, which was started in Buorkrom in Kumasi in their search for a property, has been relocated to Kenyasi- East, of the city on the outskirts of the town. They have begun a building program to have a permanent place of worship. Pastor David Okai, who leads the church now, was among the children that attended our opening service of the Tema church some forty years ago. Pray for the success of the project.

Dobonso Church gets a permanent pastor:

The church at Drobonso village, in the Ashanti Region, has finally gotten a permanent pastor in the person of Pastor Sampson Boamah. Bro. Boamah was at SRBBC for four years and preaches very well, especially in the local language. The church has since grown, and they have started helping the church at Bodomase, some twenty miles away. Pray for Bro. Boamah and his family. He is married with eight children – all of whom were hosted on campus during his four year study here at SRBBC.

Ahodwo Church loses pavilion:

A rain storm that hit the Eastern Region destroyed the pavilion we had built for this young church. It was a blow, but we are praising God for receiving sponsorship from some of our supporters which has made it possible for a more permanent structure to be raised in its place. Work is far advanced, so we are hoping to have a new roof in place by the middle of August. Praise the Lord, and thanks to all who responded to our call for assistance.

Funerals at SRBC- Dobro and Tema:

Within the quarter we lost a member in the campus church - Mrs. Victoria Kwakye-53, and another member in the Tema Church - Mr. Christopher Nagai-88. Both were buried in their respective hometowns of Kukuom, Eastern Region and Dodowa, Greater Accra Region. Kukuom was three hour drive from Dobro while Dodowa was an hour drive. Both funerals gave opportunity to give a gospel witness to the large crowds that thronged in to mourn with the families, and many prayed to receive Christ after the message.

SRBC, Tema marks 40th anniversary:

The Solid Rock Baptist Church of Tema C2 will celebrate its 40th anniversary on August 20th and 21st. Many activities are in place to mark the celebration, including fundraising to begin a Christian school. There is a homecoming thanksgiving service, where some thirty pastors, who have come out of this church and some of its daughter churches, are expected to attend. Pray that it will be a success and stir up a revival among the pastors and church members.

A new church is inaugurated:

On July 17, 2022, I was in the Central Region, with delegates from our four sister churches in Kasoa, Adzಂತem, Panfokrom and Dominase, to inaugurate a new church in the township of Mpota South, a few miles of the Winneba Municipality. This became possible through the efforts of Pastor Michael Dossah, one of the graduates from SRBBC. The church is currently meeting in an uncompleted building. The new church needs its own property so a permanent structure can be built. Please pray for God’s provision for the young church and for the pastor and his family.

SRBBCS:

We are preparing for a modular class for our graduate students in the month of September, covering the topic of Christian Apologetics. I will be the resource person for this program. Please pray for students traveling to the program from Liberia, Sierra-Leone, and from parts of Ghana. Pray for safety and a good learning experience.

Please pray for God’s provision for:

1. SRBBC College Library and Administrative building: \$40,000 still needed.
2. Remainder Needed to Pay Off Current Ministry Vehicle: \$9,400 still needed
3. Building Projects for three young churches in Ashaiman, Comm. 22 of Tema, Adzಂತem in the Central Region, and Kenyase near Kumasi in the Ashanti Region. We are seeking to raise \$9,000 for each of these churches to help them with their roofing.
4. Two motor bikes for two of our young pastors: \$900 each.
