FAMILY NEWS

Our Christian school at Dobro has had some improvement in its enrollment, which now stands at 245 pupils. It is up by 45. While we have not fully recovered from the negative impact we suffered following the Covid-19 shut down, it is encouraging to note that enrollment is picking up again. This week our third-year students in the junior high successfully wrote their final exams that will lead them to senior high level.

SRBBC GRADUATION

In August we were blessed to have Dr. Tom Wolfe come from the USA to teach a module to our graduate students. He also had the opportunity to speak in three of our churches in Tema, Dobro, and Ahodwo. On August 7 we held our 11th graduation ceremony when 16 men who had completed their required studies received their diplomas and certificates. Two of the men were from Liberia while one was from Togo. Dr. Wolfe gave the commencement address.

CHURCH PLANTING

In May we began a youth club and Sunday school at Ahodwokese, near Nsawam in the Eastern Region. So far over 150 children have enrolled. We praise the Lord for providing land and a pavilion through one of our supporting churches. This past Sunday we moved from our temporal place of worship to this permanent structure. We are planning to distribute thousands of fliers in the town to introduce the church to the community. We will hold a formal inaugural service on December 5, and we will invite some of our sister

churches for their recognition of the new church in town. We will appeal for support to continue the building project for the young church. Please pray for success.

BAPTISM: We praise the Lord for a baptismal service for the campus church at Dobro when five people were baptized. Please pray for growth for the new believers in their walk with the Lord.

REVIVAL: From November 1st to 7th, we held a one-week conference on Revival and Missions at Tema, Solid Rock Baptist Church. There were many dedications during the services, and commitments were made by members to give to support some of our local missionaries.
