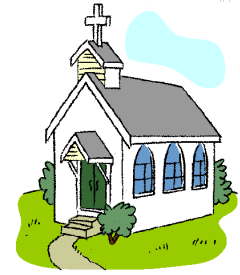

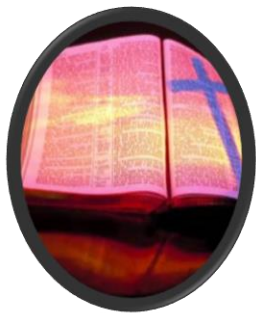
Student Handbook

Many fundamental Bible colleges are closing or have weak teaching. Many Deaf Bible colleges closed. Where do I study? Where do I learn? In **my church** is the best place.



Some Deaf go to hearing Bible colleges and don't understand all the teaching. The colleges focus on the hearing students. The teacher teaches fast. Some Deaf struggle with English. English is not my first language. English college books are hard to understand. I want to study the Bible in my language and focus on me. **I can study.** Where? My church and this Deaf Bible Institute. The teachers will use my sign language. The books and teaching guides are written for the Deaf.

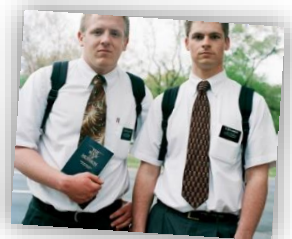

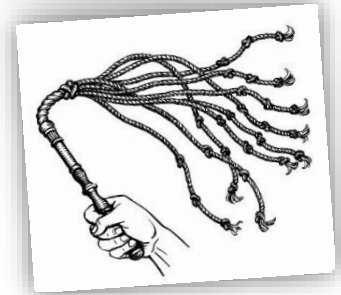
