
We pray this letter finds you well and enjoying the spiritual blessings we share in Christ. Before beginning with a ministry update, I want to praise God and tell you that we are enormously thankful for your support.

God allowed Joao to be placed as a missionary in the bordering zone of Uruguay and Brazil, where the Uruguayan city of Rivera meets with the Brazilian city of Santana do Livramento. Josias is also living in a bordering zone right now, where the city of Artigas in Uruguay, meets with Quarai, Brazil. Meanwhile, Maria and I remain in Mercedes, Argentina. I rejoice that, by God's grace, without any merit of my own, God has gifted me with a missionary family of absolute conviction. We couldn't ask for anything greater in this life - that God called our sons into His service. We remember the many years we prayed for Josias and Joao, as they studied difficult courses like Greek, Theology, Church History, and many other important subjects to prepare themselves for the ministry that awaited them in the future. They passed those courses and are now beginning their future before our very eyes. They are already on the mission field and putting everything they learned in their studies and local churches into practice. Amen! We continue praying for these three works and for the Lord to give us many more workers in the future. Josias, Joao, and I already have brothers in these three zones with whom we serve. Thank God, and thank you very much. In a sense, we ignore the past blessings in our lives and focus instead on today, the beginning of a great missionary work that awaits us in the future and will continue until His second, visible coming to Earth. In Christ Jesus, Amen. We look forward to informing you as the missionary works advance in these three zones in the near future. We also hope to share news with you about other zones according to the growth the Lord gives.

In Rivera, Uruguay, Joao is giving Bible classes to a brother named Eduardo. We've known this brother for many years. He wants to deepen his biblical understanding and grow in the Lord. He is congregating with Joao. Joao is also doing visitation with the purpose of starting a new meeting in the house of a sister named Yolanda. She accepted Christ years ago when I was pastor there. I remember the moment well. I was preaching over the shed blood of the Lord Jesus and how He saves us. I saw she was very attentive. When I finished preaching, I came down from the pulpit, and Yolanda came directly to me. She said, "I am saved. I believe that Christ forgave me of my sins with His blood." And, she remains faithful to this day. Her daughter, Yesica, also accepted Christ. Her husband's name is Eduardo (a different Eduardo). Others have accepted Christ there, and that's where Joao will hold meetings. Please pray for Yolanda and her family.

Josias has been called by God to preach His Word. He loves to talk about God's grace demonstrated by Christ on the cross, from which God gives undeserved gifts to all those who put their faith in God. He has a group in Artigas, Uruguay, to whom he preaches. He also preaches to various groups through the internet. He has numerous contacts in Artigas, among believers and non-believers.

Please continue praying for both of our sons (pictured to the right) as they serve the Lord full-time, evangelizing the respective zones where the Lord has placed them. We have a fund through IPM designated for Joao and Josias's support. IPM's Latin America Regional Director, Giovanni Avendaño, has encouraged believers he knows to send monthly support for their work, and last month, both of them received some financial help that made an impact on their work. My sons were so happy! This is fruit of those who support missionaries, who by grace dedicate their lives to the gospel.



Here in Mercedes, God is at work as well. A man by the name of Dario (pictured to the left) recently came to Christ. He is a carpenter, and he gifted me a beautiful pulpit. Dario has a very large family, like many here. I'd like to ask you to pray with us for his family members and their salvation. Another young girl accepted Christ. Her name is Juanita, and she is the daughter to a sister in the church. Lorena, the daughter-in-law to a different sister in our church, also affirmed her faith in Christ recently. Each believer in the church has their respective contacts for whom they ask prayer every week. They come with great needs, both physical and spiritual. Please pray for the following individuals specifically: Camila who has cancer and needs to be saved; Silvia's sister who is ill and needs to be saved; the salvation of Hector, Marlen, Juan, Brother Ramon's family, and Sebastián & his children. There is a lot of need for Christ here. Please pray for this "red" zone of Mercedes in Corrientes, Argentina. Because there are no other churches nearby for miles, it is my heart's desire to fill this area with believers and churches far and wide.
