September 2022

I greet you in the precious name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. I pray and hope this email finds you rejoicing in the Lord. I appreciate you for the level of support towards my family and the ministries in Liberia.

Family:

Thanks for praying for Esther. She has completed all of her courses and is awaiting graduation. The rest of our children are still in school. Ednor has registered and started her senior year. Edwina is also in her senior year but may not enroll this semester until the Lord can provide \$500 to register. Brethren, pray for my health, as I am suffering from Diabetes. There is a need of \$150 for regular monthly treatments.

Progress:

God was able to help us build a roof for the central church building. We are trusting in God, who has started the building, to provide us with the roofing sheets. Due to the size of the building, we need about 60 bundles of zinc, at \$150 per bundle.

New Church Plant:



We are more involved now in planting new churches, as you can see on the left. Pray for those we have planted and those we are yet to plant. We are trusting God to start a new church plant in Monrovia, the capital city. Because Monrovia is the capital city, most of our international guests land there before traveling to us, and we think it is prudent to have a place to preach the gospel and host all our missionary friends. Pray with us for God's quick intervention of funds to buy the parcel of land we found in Johnsonville, as the Muslims are also attempting to purchase it.

Wedding, Baptism and Youth Camp at Yeeganpa Baptist:

I was honored to officiate a wedding at the Yeeganpa Fundamental Baptist Church and baptize several other believers. Pray for their spiritual growth. There was a youth camp also conducted by the church, and 105 people were saved. Praise the Lord!



Bible School:



After some years, we have resumed our Bible school. There are three teachers and 13 students. We were blessed to have Dr. Wolfe come over to teach two courses and visit some of our churches. Pray as we labor to train men for the service of God. Over 30 souls were saved as a result of the Bible school students' outreach or visitation.

Gospel Film Show:

One way to spread the gospel is through the Jesus Film show. Over the past few months we have had several souls come to the Lord. Pray for our team as we continue to evangelize different communities and villages.

Reopening of Schools:

We are about to resume both the hearing and deaf schools. Pray that God will help us run another successful school year. Other good news is that Pastor Bruce and his family have come to work with the deaf school and church. It is our prayer to start constructing the education building for the deaf ministry. We were also blessed to purchase a vehicle for the deaf ministry that is being used by Evangelist Zuo as he preaches to the deaf. Many thanks to those who gave, and may God bless them richly. Pray also as a team of four, including me, will be traveling to Abidjan next month for the deaf ministry.
