## Update from the Field

Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

We thank God for the blessings we receive from His hand through you. Thank you for your prayers. It is a joy to be able to write you and greet you again. We pray that the Lord's grace is with each of you, strengthening you in His Word and encouraging you in your service to Him.

Just like everyone else, the pandemic has hit us hard in all areas of life here. After having had COVID and facing some of its lingering effects, God allowed me to recover and begin congregating again. In March, we opened the church temple to in-person services, careful to implement sanitary measures. Sadly, many of our guests and children haven't returned to attend. Many parents haven't sent their children out of fear of contagion. However, we thank God for the many believers who desire to congregate and enjoy communion with God and with other believers in-person. We also resumed our weekly work plan for this year: distributing brochures in the market on Mondays, distributing brochures in the city center and banks on Tuesday mornings and soul-winning on Tuesday evenings, discipleship and visitation on Wednesdays, Bible institute and prayer service on Thursdays, and soul-winning again on Fridays. On Saturdays, we have temporarily suspended our ministry activity of preaching and handing out snacks in the hospital because of the COVID restrictions in place there. Meanwhile, our preaching ministry on the radio was also put on hold while I was sick with COVID. Unfortunately, after recovering, they didn't give us permission to return.

In April, we added Sunday school back in to our in-person services (at first, we only had the main message in the morning and small groups in the evening). The government loosened restrictions, allowing everyone to congregate - even children. So at the end of April, we were able to celebrate Children's Day which was a great blessing.
