We really appreciate your faithful prayers for the missionary work since, as we all know, we are facing difficult situations throughout the world. The economy, unemployment, Covid infections, as well as different types of diseases that have come, are really very disturbing for many. Even worse, though, we see that people are incredulous to the gospel, and there is discouragement among the members of the churches. Through this all, the grace, mercy, and the love of God has sustained us, so we always thank Him. We are pleased to share what God is doing here in Raboso, Izucar de Matamoros, Puebla.

In the Evangelistic work:

Thank God, we continue to preach in the villages of Guadalupe Allende (El Pitayo) and now San José Cañada Grande (Jaulillas). Every Tuesday, in the town of Pitayo, God has allowed us to have fellowship and meet between 8 and 10 people for discipleship. In the town of Jaulillas, thanks to God, 4 people became saved: Amalia and her children, Emanuel (17) and German (14) and sister Antonia. For now, we are discipling them and praying for Hilarino Aguilar's husband and her brother for salvation. We are praying also for German, husband of sister Amalia, so that he may also be saved. In the town of Tepapaya, thank God, Brother Javier and his wife Silvia were baptized.

Activities:

From April 11-16, God allowed us to have Vacation Bible School, where we had 50 children in the morning, and, in the afternoon, God allowed us to have practical classes about discipleship. The theme was The Parables of the Lord Jesus.

In May, in El Pitayo, we had an activity for Mother's Day. We praise God as we saw answered prayer, since there were 35 people who came to listen to the Word, and, that day, 10 people stayed in the mission. On Thursday, by the grace of God, we continued the institute class.

God also allowed us this year to start meetings of ladies and men in the church, and we do this once a month. In the month of August, we had the activity of the Vacation Bible School in El Pitayo. The classes were held at the same time that adults were taught.
