Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ, We bring you greetings in the wonderful name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. April 2022

Family News: It is hard to believe that the first quarter of the year has already come to a close. The fleeting nature of time serves as a reminder to me that the return of the Lord is imminent. By God’s grace, my family and I are doing well. We are also grateful to the Lord for you, your prayers, and financial support through which He has faithfully sustained us. Praise the Lord with us as we share about His blessings in our lives and ministries!

Faith Independent Baptist Church- Early in the New Year, we organized a 21-day Spiritual Emphasis to help our members prepare, through fasting and prayer, for the activities of the months ahead. This was a great encouragement. In February, we also held a 14-day fasting and prayer time to help the church focus on the ministries for the quarter. We established our theme for this year, based on Psalm 133:1, as “Christian Unity” and committed ourselves to working together to achieve this goal and grow the church.

Outreach Ministries- By the grace of God, all of our outreach ministries are doing well. Souls are being saved; the churches are growing both numerically and spiritually.

Faith Christian Academy- We rejoice that funds are coming in gradually to pay off the Faith Christian Academy indebtedness. Currently we have a balance of \$25,512 on the loan. We covet your prayers, as we trust the Lord to help pay our debt in full. Should we fail to meet the loan obligations, we would be forced to increase school fees.

Opportunities: I was invited by the Berean Baptist Church in Lartebiorkorshie on February 13, 2022, to preach at one of their revival services. Souls rededicated their lives to the Lord. The Dansoman Baptist Church also invited me on March 20, 2022, to preach during the Sunday Morning Religious services.

Travel to Ivory Coast- I was in the Ivory Coast from January 14 to 19, 2022, to take part in the graduation ceremony of the Mission *Baptiste Fondamentale* Bible School. Ten candidates graduated. The graduation ceremony was climaxed with the award of an honorary Degree of Doctor of Divinity posthumously to Rev. Nao. His wife, who was present at the occasion, received the certificate. I preached at the ceremony on the theme “Charge to a soldier of Christ” (2 Timothy 4:1-5). I also preached on Sunday Morning on the theme “Living Together in Unity.” From Monday to Wednesday afternoon, I took the executives of the Mission *Baptiste Fondamentale* (MBF) through some teachings of IPM.

Please pray with us concerning our country and the world at large. All of the economies of the world are in shock, occasioned by the global pandemic and the Russian invasion of Ukraine. The woes of the Ghanaian economy is worsening due to a rapid depreciation of the currency and escalating inflation. The depreciation of our currency needs to be remedied as soon as possible.

AFRICA MINISTRIES

Africa Baptist Bible Mission, Kenya:

Churches: Since January 2021, the mission has not been able to resume to full operation. Many of their ministries were crippled, as many people could not return to church post-CoVid 19. Many job losses have made people, especially from our small towns, move to larger towns for a livelihood. The weather has also worsened the situation due to lack of rains, so even

our farmers have been affected. Currently, our Children, Women, Youth, and Men Ministries are functional and have brought great excitement to members. We trust the Lord for resumption of activities in our Ministry to the Deaf, Evangelism, Wellness Ministry (This typically hosts Medical Missions Outreach), and Mid-week fellowships.

Bible College-- With God's help, the mission is hopeful to run six block classes this year. Their prayer is to grow and offer more block classes in different locations. Eventually, they hope to be able to host these block classes here in Nyahururu and have a fixed timetable for classes. The mission also hopes to introduce a Bible Conference focusing on pastors and ministry workers/leaders within our local churches.

Missions and Church-planting--The Africa Baptist Bible Mission is grateful to the Lord for what they have been able to achieve in the last two years in their church-planting work. Two Churches now have buildings to worship in every Sunday. This is a great success and a huge step towards the autonomy of these churches. They strongly believe that strong and healthy churches can only sprout and grow from robust congregations. The goal is to settle them in a location and heighten the work of discipleship and evangelism.

Solid Rock Baptist Missions, Ghana

NEW CHURCH INAUGURATED--The mission praises the Lord for the successful inauguration on December 5 of a new Church at the township of Ahodwo-kese in the Eastern Region. There were about one hundred and fifty people in attendance, with close to 50% coming from the township. This was the mission's 40th effort in church planting and commemorated the 40th anniversary of Solid Rock Baptist Missions. An appeal we launched at the service yielded 104 bags of cement to help this young church in its building project. A supporting church has helped acquire land and build a pavilion, which is being remodeled.

CHILDREN'S RALLY--The mission held a successful children's rally at the SRBBC campus for four of their young churches that are close by the college. It was the first rally that the mission had organized since the COVID 19 pandemic, so the mission really praises the Lord for making it possible.
