Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

August 2022

I bring you greetings in the precious name of our soon coming King! By God's grace, my wife and I are doing well. His grace has been sufficient for us through our ministry and daily life at home.

FAITH INDEPENDENT BAPTIST CHURCH: The current world situation calls for God's intervention. Our country's economy is getting worse by the day, but, as a church, we still believe that we have a prayer-answering God. We therefore organized five days of fasting and prayers to strengthen our spiritual lives for the ministry ahead of us. The saints were edified during the five days of self-denial, and we can only wait to see what the Lord will do in the next few weeks and months through our members. We also organized three days of fasting and prayers for our country, trusting that the Lord will bring us out of our economic woes. Presently, none of our members has been infected by the Corona virus, thanks to God! During the period under review, I baptized fourteen people and they were added to the church.

FAITH CHRISTIAN ACADEMY: We rejoice that funds are coming in gradually to pay off their indebtedness. Currently we have a balance of \$24,512 to offset our loan. We covet your prayers, as we trust the Lord to help pay our debt in full. Should we fail to meet the loan obligations, we would be forced to increase school fees.

OUTREACH MINISTRIES: Our two ministries in Winneba and Mpota are doing well. Even though church attendance is not as encouraging as it should be due to the current economic situation in the country, I still believe the Lord will turn things around soon. Please pray with us.

COVID19 PANDEMIC: Current national active cases for Covid19 as at July 22, 2022 are 606. All CoVid restrictions have been relaxed. Praise God!

AFRICA MINISTRIES

GREAT COMMISSION FUNDAMENTAL BAPTIST MISSION, LIBERIA:

Church's Project: The mission wants to thank friends and donors, at home and in the United States, who gave generously towards the roofing of their central church building.

Women Conference: The national women's conference just ended. It brought over 500 women from different independent Baptist churches. The conference is trusting God for provision to continue their conference center project.

Schools: Both the hearing and deaf schools are doing well. There are about 600 hearing students and 48 deaf students. The construction of the dormitories for the deaf students has been completed. The next project will be the main school building.

Prayer Request: Please pray for the economic situation in Liberia. Prices are escalating every day.

EGLISE BAPTIST MID-MISSION OF CHAD:

Bebedjia Church: Church activities have now resumed after the restrictions due to the Covid-19. The mission is planning to start evangelism work soon. Please pray with the mission to be able to bring this to fruition. The mission plans to start a preaching point in Sarh, but Covid-19 prevented them from doing so. They are planning to start as soon as the Lord permits. Kindly remember them in your prayers as well.

Deaf Ministry: The mission now has 38 pupils in their deaf school, with three female teachers. There was a National Deaf Bible Camp from April 13-17, 2022. The mission is happy that they were able to send their students. They thank the Lord for providing traveling expenses for those who attended.

Praises: The mission praises the Lord for keeping the ministry running in Chad. They also praise God that churches have resumed activities that were under restriction due to the Covid-19 pandemic. The moreover praise the Lord for opening doors for evangelism.

Prayer requests: Evangelization in Sarh; Evangelization in Bongor; National Deaf Bible Conference in Sarh; Peace in Sandana as herdsmen killed 21 farmers. This village is close to Sarh.

ETHIOPIA

Rejoice with us! The mission praises the Lord that the first church they planted has now been legally registered. They thank you for your help and prayers on the registration.

Work of Evangelism: The mission's evangelistic work in the city is done five days a week and has resulted in 198 people hearing the gospel in the last three months. The mission has distributed evangelistic literature and done follow-ups with many of the people. Two people were saved and have since been going through discipleship lessons and regularly attending the church services. One lady and her family, from a Charismatic background, are now attending the mission's church because of the Bible truths they received from the church. The lady faithfully attended Dr. Kevin Callahan's teaching on the Holy Spirit.


Two days teaching: Pastor Haileleul Emiru came from the States in March and taught on the topic, "The Heart God Doesn't Despise." His four messages were based on Psalm 51:17. He taught how to repent and trust on the mercy of God for true Christian living and ministry. On Sunday morning, over 100 people were in attendance as he preached two gospel messages, praise God!
