I bring you greetings from our soon-coming Lord and King. The prophet Isaiah says in Isaiah 9:6, *"For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace."* My wife and I wish to express our heartfelt appreciation to you and your congregation for the prayers, financial support, and encouragement you have exhibited throughout the year. Although I am retired from Faith Independent Baptist Church, I still preach on the first Sunday of every month and serve the Lord's supper. Weddings and funerals engage me actively as well.

NEW MINISTRY

Presently, the Lord has given me a new ministry, an orphanage and a Christian school. The orphaned children in our community and beyond may beam with new hope. My missionary trail as Africa Regional Director for IPM gets busier. Uganda is the newest mission post. I will be in that country in March, 2023 Lord willing. My wife and I are in Mississippi at the moment, catching up on needed rest that has eluded us for years. We arrived here on August 28, 2022. We return to Ghana to January, 2023. We covet your prayers. **Please pray with us for the following:**

1. For the Lord to provide the necessary funds to pay off the debt of \$21,015 for Faith Christian Academy.
2. For the economy of Ghana to improve. We have hit 50 percent inflation as of the end of November, 2022.
3. For the Lord to provide the funds for the orphanage and the Christian School.

AFRICA MINISTRIES

AFRICA BAPTIST BIBLE MISSION - KENYA:

Church Plants: The mission has started a new work at Gwa Kung'u and has been holding open-air meetings to strengthen her reach in the surrounding areas. Also, they are looking for a more strategic area to rent a hall and be able to look for a place to secure land for a permanent home. Another work has also started in Umoja Mbuyu, Leshau area in Nyandarua County, and the Lord is blessing with souls being saved. The mission is excited to finally be able to move to this new location.

Laikipia Baptist Bible Institute: The Bible Institute is going well. They just closed the year with a class on church planting. This class, "Building Blocks of Church Planting," examined the work of the Apostle Paul as the Lord used him to plant churches in his world.

GREAT COMMISSION FUNDAMENTAL BAPTIST MISSION - LIBERIA:

Church Roof Project: The mission is thankful for the church roof project. They have completed the church steel roofing work and are now trusting the Lord for the roofing sheets. The building will take 60 bundles of zinc/roofing sheets. They have gotten only four bundles so far and are still trusting our Lord for the 56 additional bundles needed. Each bundle cost \$150.00, besides the labor.

Christian Foundation School: The Christian Foundation School has opened for the 2022-2023, academic year. However, they are struggling with poor enrollment due to the economy.

Praises and prayer requests : We are very thankful to God for His goodness. The Lord provided a motorcycle for our evangelist, Mordecai Barlea, and a vehicle for Pastor Japheth A Zuo to run the affairs of the DEAF.

Rev. Edwin N. Gbor's Health: Kindly remember Rev. Gbor in your prayers for his health. He is the founder of the Great Commission Baptist Mission and also my co-laborer in the Lord. A couple of months ago, he was diagnosed with diabetes, and it costs him over \$100.00 per month for his medical upkeep.

THE SOLID ROCK BAPTIST MISSION:

Rebuilding the Ahodwo Church Pavilion: A rainstorm that hit the Eastern Region destroyed the pavilion the mission had built for this young church. It was a blow, but the mission is praising God for receiving sponsorship from some of our supporters which has made it possible for a more permanent structure to be raised in its place. Work is far advanced, so we are hoping to have a new roof in place by the middle of August. Praise the Lord, and thanks to all who responded to our call for assistance.

A new church is inaugurated: On July 17, 2022, the mission met in the Central Region, with delegates from four sister churches of the mission -- Kaso, Adzentem, Panfokrom, and Dominase, to inaugurate a new church in Mpot South, a few miles off the Winneba Municipality. This became possible through the efforts of Pastor Michael Dossah, one of the graduates of the Solid Rock Baptist Bible College. The church is currently meeting in an uncompleted building. Please pray for the provision of a worship place for the young church and for needs of the pastor and his family.

Please pray for God's provision for:

1. Library and Administrative building: \$40,000 still needed.
2. Two motorbikes for two of our young pastors: \$900 each.
