I pray and trust that this update finds you well in the Lord. We are doing very well here in Nyahururu, and we praise the Lord for you all daily, for your love and support for our ministry. We know many of you have been praying for us since we sent the last letter, and we are eternally thankful.

In my last update, I asked for prayers for my wife and our then-unborn child. The Lord answered all our prayers. A baby girl, Mayamiko Njoroge, was added to our family on the 23rd of February, 2021. She is a healthy and beautiful girl, and we praise the Lord for her. Lydia is doing well and has been busy taking care of our two girls amidst the "stay-at-home" order due to COVID-19. Also, I asked for your prayers for a financial breakthrough, and here I lay an Ebenezer! We are well sustained, and we will soon move to a new house. We wanted our baby to be at least three months old before we moved.

Although, just before we had our first class in our first location, Nyahururu, new orders from the government came restricting movement, closing all schools, and banning gatherings. This was discouraging since we had been preparing for this class since 2020. The good news is that towards the end of April the restrictions lightened, and we were allowed to meet in Doldol, our second location of Bible classes. I went there for a week from the 26th to the 30th of April and had a wonderful class on "Methods of Bible Interpretation." The next set of classes is scheduled for the month of August. We are trusting God that things will be better then.

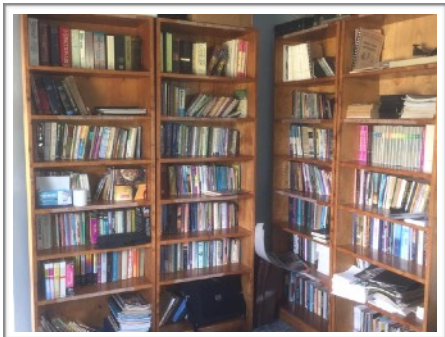
Praise the Lord for our church school. By the close of last term, we had 40 kids. This is 15 more than we used to have. Thank you for praying for this to take shape. We are trusting God for a better term starting in mid-May. We hope by the grace of God to increase our capacity by building more classrooms in the future so that the school can begin to fund some church programs. For the first time in the history of the school, we had meetings with the parents; attendance was 100%. I preached to the parents, and the kids blessed the Lord with songs and memory verses in our hearing.

We currently have about 500 books, and we expect to receive a donation of approximately 400 books in July through a friend from www.christianbook.com. This will be a great blessing to our people and to the college for many years to come.

With the Lord's help, we have been able to resume a construction project for one of our church plants, Baraka Bible Baptist Church, where Pastor Muthui serves. We have purchased most of the needed supplies, and we are waiting for the rains to subside to do the fabrication of terraces on site. We hope to complete the church structure this month. Thank you for your continued prayers and support.

Ministry to the Deaf

This has seen better days. Prior to the new COVID-19 scare and lockdown, we were ministering to a nearby school with a special unit, and one of our young church members, Angela, is a helper there. Angela plans to get certification from the government specifically for sign language to be more effective in ministry.
