Dear prayer partners and supporters,

Two weeks ago, we camped out in a village called Awoto Aol for two days, preaching the gospel of Jesus. This is a village where no sound church exists. The only church I saw was a Catholic church. The people in this place are steeped in tradition and religion. We always travel with interpreters to accommodate for the language differences. It was hard to get through to the people at first, but by the end of the first day, 19 people gave their lives to Christ. On the second day, 33 people placed their faith in Christ. This group of new believers is big enough for a new church plant. The problem we were faced with is that we didn't have anyone trained and ready to be sent out as a church planter.



Thankfully, there is a man named Ronald who about a year ago had approached me and asked for theology lessons. I had been meeting with him on a weekly basis to instruct and discuss the Bible with him. As it turned out, Ronald's house was the closest place these new converts can meet.

Therefore, we have left Ronald with a heavy duty of following up with these people and discipling them. It is true that the harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. This is one of the glaring problems that is plaguing the work of evangelizing the world. There are few believers going out of their way to simply preach the glorious gospel of our Savior. There might be many reasons why this is the case. However, there is another problem which in my estimation might even pose a greater challenge to the task of evangelizing the world. This is the problem of false evangelists who preach a 'different' gospel which is not really the gospel. I live in a place where large outdoor meetings are still an effective way of getting the gospel out and calling people to respond. As a church, we try as much as possible to take advantage of this open-door opportunity. What we observe that we find quite disheartening are the underhanded methods employed by those who also claim to be engaged in the work of evangelism.

Our goal is to train enough church leaders so that when we go out for evangelism, we always have someone we can send out in that very place to disciple the new believers. Currently, there are six young men going through such a training. Please pray that the Lord will raise up even more for this very purpose. Also, we would love to be able to carry out these evangelistic meetings more often and in more places than we currently do. There are thousands of people in villages around us who have not heard the true gospel preached. While that door is still open, we want to take advantage of it. The biggest challenge we currently have is transportation, and the lack of a sizable public address sound system. Please pray with us that the Lord would provide a vehicle and the sound system for this evangelistic work.

Fundraising for our church building is still going on. So far, we have raised \$37,000 of the required \$57,200 for the project. The door is still open to anybody who is able to give.
