

By God’s grace, we have met our target for the funds required to construct our church building. The project is already ongoing. Most of the materials have been purchased and are in place. The foundation is complete. The church members have been laying bricks, and we already have more than 20,000 bricks. The superstructure wall construction phase of the project is just starting. Glory be to God! Thank you to who all who gave towards the construction of this sanctuary where hundreds will gather each week to worship the Lord.

The Water project is also done and fully operational. Thank you for giving to provide clean and safe drinking water to the community of Bedmot. The meeting of this physical need has given us uncountable and continuing opportunities to share Christ, who gives living water to those who thirst.

Outreaches

This December, we are conducting the last of four big outreaches for this year. We will then conclude with a week-long itinerant showing of the Jesus Film leading up to Christmas Day. The Lord has been so gracious in the way He has worked through these evangelistic outreaches to save the souls of many. We are constantly amazed at what happens when we go out there. This year, we have seen over 170 people coming to Christ within our village and the surrounding villages. Thank you for your continued prayers for these people.

Church Planting and Theological Training

The need to plant healthy churches is much greater than I had even anticipated. But church planting is predicated on the training of sound teachers which is also not an easy task, one that takes time. Nevertheless, the Lord has given us some young men who are very promising, and we are looking to partner with a university called Shepherds Training Center (Sufficiency of Scripture Ministries) located about three hours away from us. This collaboration is important and necessary

seeing that one person cannot constitute a whole school. As we work to build and setup our own infrastructure for Bible Training, we need to get the men who are present and ready training using other available opportunities. These will be the same men to become teachers and participate in the process of training other men and women for the ministry. I strongly believe that it is necessary for Uganda and Africa at large to have multiple sound Bible Institutes in order to try and

curb the widespread problem of false teaching in churches. The more established Bible schools and colleges should therefore collaborate with the upcoming schools to become equally solid to serve the Lord's church.
