23 BAPTIZED, MORE ADDED TO CHURCH MEMBERSHIP!

Last week, we baptized 23 believers at church as pictured on the right. By God's grace, within the last year and a half, many people have come to trust Christ as Lord and Savior as a result of hearing His Word preached at Lubangakene Bible Church. The whole of last year, we taught the reality of the Church of Christ, and what Christ, the Chief Shepherd, expects of us, his sheep. This year, we have started enrolling into church membership those who are believers, have been baptized, and have understood and agreed to the church's statement of faith.



OUTREACHES

Early this year, we took a 70-man team in a large truck to a small town called Omiya Anyima, in Kitgum District (four hours away), for a three-day mission trip. The journey was long, but very exciting, as people were singing in the back of that truck the whole time. The majority of the people slept on the floor at the host church while we were there. Every day started early at 5AM, with an hour long time of prayer and intercession. The team would then freshen up and take breakfast before 8AM, followed by two hours of conference sessions, and another two hours of door-to-door evangelism, before convening in one place for the open-air preaching. By the end of the three days, 168 had been saved. It was an amazing work of the Lord's hand.

PROJECTS

Last month, we had the privilege of hosting Mr. Bob VanWingerden and his son, Blake, from Calvary Baptist Church in Maryland. We were very encouraged and helped by their presence and advice in regards to how we can better utilize our existing land for productive crop farming. The gardens we plant here have been very helpful to provide food for ministry workers and food for various church events. We are looking to install some irrigation systems to help us attain better yield.

Construction of the church building is almost at the roofing stage. We appreciate all your support that has made this possible. At the moment, one of the greatest needs here at the ministry is a means of transportation. We need a truck which would be multi-purpose in nature for transporting tools, materials, produce, furniture, equipment for outreach, and even sometimes ferrying people to places for various purposes. We request that

you please pray for us and consider giving to help us acquire this truck, as it would be of great assistance in facilitating the execution of the mission God has given here. We have raised 24% (\$5,000) of the total \$21,000 so far.
