We bring you greetings in the name of our soon-coming King, and we thank the Lord for His keeping power and grace that saw us through the year 2021 in the face of the pandemic. We thank the Lord for bringing us into a new year- it is unbelievable that January has ended! We are grateful to God for His healing power shown to my family. Just before Christmas and during the festivities every member of the family got sick, but God, our Great Healer has restored our health for which we are very thankful. We are happy to share with you what is happening in our ministry, and thank you very much for your prayer and financial support, special gifts and letters of encouragement you send to us. They mean a lot to us.

EBENEZER BAPTIST CHURCH: The Lord continues to encourage our people to attend the services and activities of the church. Sunday morning services have returned to normalcy, and the attendance continues to grow in spite of the Covid-19/Omicron restrictions. Attendance for Sunday school and Wednesday prayer meeting is still low, but we pray these services will also pick up in attendance.

CHURCH EXPANSION WORKS: Members have generously and sacrificially given towards this work, and a good part of the project has been completed. We are left with the final phase to complete the overall expansion works we have initiated for some years now. We are very thankful to God for providing to meet our needs. Please pray with us that God will provide the needed resources to complete this work.

SALVATION: It was a great joy to have the opportunity to talk to a group of twelve young female footballers about Jesus Christ. At the end, they each prayed to receive Jesus Christ as their personal Savior. Pray that these will grow in the Lord as we disciple them.

EBENEZER BAPTIST CHRISTIAN SCHOOL: Our Christian school continues to grow. At the beginning of the new academic year we lost some of our students as a result of parents relocating. However we were compensated by the enrollment of new students. The population of the school now stands at 725 as against 750 before we went on the Christmas break. The school has employed a total of

forty-five teaching and non-teaching staff. The needs of the school remains

the same - we need more computers and school buses to convey school children to and fro home. Please continue to pray with us that these needs will be met by the Lord through His people. We thank the Lord that we are able to resume Wednesday worship service for our students which was suspended as a result of the Covid-19 outbreak.



THE CHRISTIAN SCHOOL IN MY HOMETOWN: The enrollment in the school has gone down because of the government's free education in the public schools. Notwithstanding, we are thankful to the Lord for the current enrollment, believing that there will be new admissions during this new academic year. At the moment we have 100 students and 8 teachers. This school also needs some computers. We are still working on the school building. Pray with us that the Lord will provide the needed funds to plaster and screed the floors of the classrooms

GOD IS ABLE PASTORAL MINISTRY (GIAPM): The ministry, which was launched in March 2020, a day before the country went under lockdown because of Covid-19, has not been able to roll out the programs and activities for our pastors. We have held a few meetings with some of our pastors which has always been very refreshing and encouraging. Currently we are helping 36 pastors access reliable insurance to put their families in the best position as they work for the Lord. Pray with us that the ministry will, by God's help, meet the needs of our pastors as we labour together.

FAMILY NEWS: A few days before and during Christmas, every member of the family got sick, but the Lord took care of us and restored our health to normalcy, for which we are grateful. Our son Isaac has finished his four years studies at the university and is doing a compulsory National Service. Dorcas, our daughter, is in her final year at the university, and will complete her four year course in June. We thank God for taking care of them whilst in school away from home.
