We bring you greetings in the name of our soon-coming King and Savior, Jesus Christ, who, by His unailing and sustaining grace, has brought us this far. We are grateful to God for your partnership in ministry with us. Your faithful and consistent prayer and financial support have hugely impacted our ministry. The letters you send to us, assuring us that you are praying for us, have always been very encouraging. We would like to share with you what the Lord is doing in our part of the world.

In March, my wife and I were invited by the pastor of a Baptist church in Wa, which is located in the northern part of the country, to organize and teach a two-day pastors' and wives' conference to aid them in building stronger ministries. The northern area of the country is quite deprived and predominantly Muslim. There are few opportunities for white or blue-collar employment, and most of the inhabitants are farmers. The temperature was around 99⁰F! By road, it is a fourteen hour trip (one-way), but an airstrip has recently been built, allowing planes to land. We were therefore fortunate to use the less-stressful means of transportation, by taking a 90-minute flight! The conference venue was Hallelujah Baptist Church. I spoke to the pastors on how to build doctrinally strong, sound churches, and Anna led the pastors' wives' in a discussion on how they can effectively support their husbands' ministries. Both sessions were very well attended, with lively discussion, even though we both needed to use translators.

The church has recovered very well from COVID-19. Since we resumed services, attendance on Sunday mornings has been very encouraging. Our Sunday school attendance, as well as our mid-week services, have not picked up as we had expected. We have had many births in the church, for which we are thankful to God. We have also had the joy of honoring some senior citizens who have celebrated their 70th birthdays.

We revived our missions program in the church in February, to enable us to support more pastors and church planters in the rural areas. The response so far has been very encouraging. Pray with us, that the excitement with which we have begun will be sustained. In recent times we have had heavy rains, which have adversely affected some members. Houses have been flooded, and, in the process, property has been lost. Unfortunately, the church is not in a position to help replace that which has been lost, but we would appreciate your prayers that God might provide for their needs.

EBENEZER BAPTIST CHRISTIAN SCHOOL

The school population continues to grow. Currently, we have over seven hundred students, and there is the need to expand in order to accommodate more students. Our need for a school shuttle bus still remains unmet. We also need more computers. Please support us with your prayers, that these needs would be supplied by the Lord through His people.

GOD IS ABLE PASTORAL MINISTRY

A good number of pastors are showing interest in the vision and objectives of the ministry to assist our pastors. So far, forty-six pastors have joined one of our programs. Pray with us, that more pastors will catch the vision and join.

Plans to organize a three-day residential seminar in October 2022 are far advanced. One of the pastors of one of our supporting churches has graciously offered to serve as the main resource person. Please pray for him as he prepares to come over! Also pray that we will be able to raise some funds to help subsidize the cost of the seminar, so that more pastors will be able to attend.

FAMILY

The Lord continues to bless us as a family. We are thankful to God for His goodness. On March 14, Alfred celebrated his 67th birthday, and on April 11, we celebrated our 35th wedding anniversary! The Lord heard our cry, and our son, Isaac, has recently secured a job after completing his college degree in Business Management last year. Our daughter, Dorcas, completed her college degree in Human Resource Management in May and is currently waiting on the Lord for employment. In May, Anna retired from service as the church administrator, and she is now fully involved in the GIAPM ministry and enjoying her hobby of cultivating oyster mushrooms!
