Planting Churches / Our mission

We re-leased for this year at the Sevierville Community Center to have our Bible studies and discipleship. The Lord has opened this door for us for now, for which we are thankful. Preparing Through Education

I want to inform you that I am now part of the education department (for the Spanish-speaking world) in Spanish of the Mission Board to which I belong (IPM). This will be in addition to my current church planting ministries. The purpose of this new ministry is to assist missionaries and national pastors in the training of workers through Biblical Institutes or Seminars in the curriculum they have. Part of the Education Department's ministry is helping our partner institutions develop their curriculum, and I will help with that. In addition, I will make myself available for Bible conferences focused on the value and place of the local church. The conferences will be called "For His Church" and will have an agenda related to this approach.
