Update from the Field

Dear Friends and Servants of the Lord,

It has been a year since our former President, Jovenel Moise, was assassinated, and Haiti has yet to hold an election or find an official replacement for his position. Powerful and violent gangs have taken control of the major cities and routes throughout the country, making safe travel and transportation of goods impossible for citizens and businesses trying to survive. Yet even in the darkest times, God is faithful, and we give praise to Him. We cannot thank you enough for your faithfulness in prayerfully and financially supporting us here on the field. We are blessed with friends and supporters like you all.

A month ago, I wrote an email to a supporting church that has been hugely instrumental in helping with the needs of our clinic. It was not my reason for writing, but I briefly mentioned how we had lost a partnership with an organization here in Haiti that donated OTC medications from the States so that we could offer them free to our patients. After some of their staff members were kidnapped and held for ransom, the organization decided to shut down that part of their ministry. I wrote that email at 12:11 PM. At 2:51 PM, I received a reply saying that they had purchased exactly what we needed and had already shipped them to our Miami address!

I share this to show you as just one example of how God faithfully provides for our needs and how very thankful we are for people like you, who for the past 45 years have demonstrated your love for God by serving the least of these. (Mathew 25:40)

Our annual youth retreat back in February was a great success. 231 campers came from nearby villages and cities for 6 days here on

campus! We praise God for the opportunity to touch the lives of these teens and provide them with an environment where they can grow mentally and spiritually.

SBI will be in session this year from July 18th – Aug 12th. This year we took another step of faith, after cancelling the past two years due to COVID and insecurity. We made the decision not to accept anyone who would have to go through the city of Port-au-Prince, as it is the most dangerous area. Please pray for safety for our staff and the several hundred preachers who will be traveling from different cities to attend.

In our personal lives, we have been so blessed by God's protection whenever we need to travel, health as we work and interact with our community, and encouragement through friends and family. One of the highlights of Roysen (10) and Graysen's (7) has been the weekly basketball practice that we hold for the 5th and 6th graders at Bethesda with the highest GPAs. Several young men from our youth group have been very helpful, leading drills and games for the kids. Despite a recent knee injury, I sustained from a fall, I've still been able to play and have recovered well. Dani has really enjoyed launching her life coaching ministry and building relationships with the missionary women who God has brought her way.

Thank you so much for keeping our ministry and family in your prayers. We love you all and ask God to bless you and your families this summer. Greater is He that is in us than he that is in the world!
