Deputation Update from the States

Dear Friends,

"Delight thyself also in the LORD: and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart."
Psalms 37:4

This verse teaches us how a prayer can be answered, but it does not mention the word "prayer." It does say that we should DELIGHT in the Lord, meaning: wait on Him with perseverance. The result is that He "shall give thee the desires of thine heart." What are the things that *your* heart delights in? Psalm 37 is about the process of getting rid of all other delights except in God Himself. How wonderful it is to delight in the Lord! During these past months, we have experienced His loving care in both the big and small details. While going through a series of difficult trials lately, we have felt God's love and delighted only in Him and in His power.

Thank you, dear praying friends, for always interceding for us! We arrived in the US in late July to report to our supporting churches, individual supporters, and also to visit new churches. Getting here was bumpy...three days before our original flight, we found out the flight was completely cancelled because the airline only offered a banned (because of COVID) flight plan! Through it all, God was in control and took care of providing new flights. So, we traveled a total of 24 hours: 13 hours of flying plus 11 hours of layovers. Praise the Lord with us as we enjoy fellowship with friends and supporters here in the States, and please be praying for our time here as we travel to different states and visit about 32 churches.

The Lord is allowing us to serve Him even in this country. So far, we've had the opportunity to be a part of a week-long VBS, helping in different areas. We have also been sharing the Gospel with several Hispanic individuals who work in nearby shops. To our surprise, there is an Argentinian food market close to where we are staying. We were able to speak with Cinthia in Spanish and share the Gospel with her and others that work there.
