## NUEVA PALMIRA

In Nueva Palmira, new people are coming to church, and others are growing in the Lord. The new Youth Ministry is growing. There is an open area that could be transformed into a new classroom, but it needs new flooring, a better roof, a wall, a window and a door. Thank you for taking this need to the Throne.
