Thank you for partnering with us to reach the lost with the Gospel and edify the church. You are a blessing to our ministry. We have been busy for the Lord, and we are excited to share some updates from the field. I thank IPM for their support and acceptance of our four projects in December, 2022. I received \$6,000.00 for the Deaf Ministry purchase, part of the NAO Church reconstruction. Pray for the construction of the church of Aboisso (pictured on the left) and the purchase of the land of the institute.

Church of Port Bouet 2

Thank you for your prayers and support. There are 10 people attending baptism courses.

Church of Nouveau Bureau

The church of Nouveau Bureau was destroyed because of a bridge construction project. Because of this, the brothers and sisters there meet for their worship service in a school where they rent a classroom. Please pray for land to become available for purchase. They currently have 10 candidates for baptism. I ask for your prayers for the wife of their pastor because she has had stomach pain since an operation some years ago. Pray for the son of the pastor to pass his exam of BAC this year.

Church of Micao

Please pray for the wife of the missionary at the Church of Micao. She has not felt well since she lost her baby during pregnancy. Please pray for healing and comfort. Please also pray for David, the son of the missionary N'Zi Kouassi Hyacinthe of Micao.

Church of Soubré

This family is doing well. So far, this ministry has won 7 souls to Christ. The church has lost 2 members, Jean and Hypolite. While we grieve for the loss and pray for comfort for the families, we can rejoice in the knowledge that they were both saved. We will one day be reunited. Seven believers have been baptized so far.

Church of Aboisso

Our Gospel campaign was held December 28-30, during which 4 souls were saved. Four believers were baptized in 2022. There was one wedding on October 15, 2022. In addition, we have started an evening preaching meeting in a village named Akakro, far from Aboisso (about 26 km.)

Church of Grand Lahou

This family is doing well. On December 24, 2022, we baptized 8 people (5 men and 3 women). There are 12 new people attending the church.

Church of Ile Bouley

There are 2 new people attending this church. Survey work is being done for new mission field called Baie des Millardaire. It is near Ile Bouley.

Church of N'Dotre

N'Dotre church baptized 6 believers during the year 2022.

Church of Daloa

5 people have been baptized, and 3 are following baptism courses. We have celebrated two weddings in 2022. Students who passed their exam have been rewarded. The house of the pastor is being built.

Church of Lakota

We thank God for this ministry. We have baptized 2 people and have projects planned for two new missionary fields.

Deaf ministry update

From August 21-26, 2022, the camp of deaf ministry took place in Anyama. We have started planting two new deaf ministries in Agboville. (We are planting churches in two villages) and in Abobo. There are 15 candidates attending baptism courses. This number includes the ministries of Abobo, Agboville, Adzopé and Port Bouet 2.
