In my March 2023 Prayer Letter, I mentioned that there is a pastor and a young man who want to join me for the ministry. Now the pastor has resigned for some reason. We will pray for the Lord to send other workers in the field and students to Bible School and Seminary.

Sarh Preaching Stations:

Sarh, Moïssara village Preaching Station

Members built a shelter for their meetings to protect them from rain and sun rays.

Sarh, Jardin Quarter Preaching Station

They also built a shelter using rough materials.

To reinforce the ministry, members of this preaching station shared the Gospel through door-to-door evangelization. This took three days. We did this because many of those who had dedicated themselves to follow Jesus do not attend Sunday services. This opportunity allowed the evangelists to help with some families' problems. They prayed for those who have been sick for many days and lacking means to go to the hospital. Those who were visited appreciated the visit and were thankful to the Lord Who sent the evangelists to their houses. Among those persons who were visited at home, there were some old women and widows. The visit from the evangelists was an opportunity to encourage them to attend the Sunday services. They were relaxed and praised the Lord for His mercy. Many of them were discouraged when their husbands passed away. We thank God that they can receive true encouragement through the Lord.

The ladies had teaching on devoted women in the Bible. The chosen theme was, "Woman, recognize your role in church ministry." This ministry was meant to inspire church ladies and to boost them in church activities and ministry. Due to the ladies' daily responsibilities, the teaching took place in the afternoons for three days.

Deaf Ministry

Primary school is running well, but there has been a teachers' strike since November, 2023. Teachers are claiming some parts of their salary that have been subtracted since 2016, but the government is tough on this position, not willing to pay them.

We are still looking for teachers for the secondary school. There is a general assignment of teachers to other towns, and it is not easy to find teachers here. The strike makes it worse, since they do not come to their new assigned areas.

We praise the Lord for:

- Deaf Camp which took place in Bitkine, among Muslims.
- The door-to-door evangelization that took place in Sarh in Jardin Quarter preaching point in April, 2023.
- The Ministry in Chad.
- Building shelters for the two new preaching stations in Sarh.

Prayer requests:

- Inclusive Camp Joy in Moundou postponed for 2024.
- Deaf Camp to take place in March 2024 in Bere.
- For Jardin Quarter preaching station for deliverance from alcoholism, witchery, and tradition.
- Next Evangelization in Sarh, to reinforce Moïssara preaching station.
- Teachers for Deaf Secondary School and their training in sign language.
- New converts to be trained in discipleship techniques.
- Pray for the new believers to participate in church services.
- Evangelization in Bongor.
- Leadership training to help in planting churches.
- Sending a person to Bible Seminary.
