CHRISTIAN FOUNDATION SCHOOL

We thank God for our Christian school. Last year was a difficult one for us. However, we still ended the year with a little over 400 students. 80 students in our 12th grade class graduated, after passing the government examination successfully. Currently, 450 students have enrolled for our 20232-024 academy, of which 80% have paid some fees.



Within the junior high section, 14 students got saved, while 6 were saved in the senior high division. Praise God for these pupils. Some are attending our regular church services. In all, twenty souls got saved for the quarter.
