About 12 years ago, Sister Vilma, (wearing a red blouse in the photo), was saved. She is very faithful to prayer meetings. In


(Roselia), brother (Hugo), and daughter (Fabiola). Tonight, her niece, Daniela, visited. This is a picture with some of her relatives.
