Dear Brothers.

It is a joy to greet you in this new year. We are grateful to the Lord for His faithfulness in everything we have had to undertake.

In the previous letter, we shared that I have had several invitations, both from Argentina and the United States. Just a few days ago, they called me again. They told me that it is a very large church, which has three groups, with an average of 300 people in each. In that church, there are Americans and Latinos, therefore I have been asked for the PDF of my book, "Evangelismo Workshop," to be translated into English.

Their desire is to not only give the church theoretical lessons on evangelism, but to also create an outreach time with people who wish to go out to put the lessons on evangelism into practice.

For now, the practical part is the primary focus, as I do not always have the opportunity of going with the brothers of the church to public roads or house-to-house.

In the last months of 2023, I spent a lot of time preparing a page with more than 80 internet blocks for people in the Mormon sect. It has been and remains a very hard work. So far, about 10,000 people have visited the page, which gives me a lot of encouragement.

I also visited two churches, where I taught evangelism and a class on religious occultism.

On March 22-24, I am giving an evangelism workshop in a new church in the federal capital. In April, I am scheduled to teach at the Biblical Institute for Word of Life in San Miguel del Monte. Last year, I had 174 students. This year, the same number of students from different countries are expected.





If I travel to the US this year, I would have two additional opportunities for biblical institutes pending for the second half of the year, one in San Salvador de Jujuy and a new one that has just begun in the province of Salta, both in North Argentina.



As brothers will realize, my ministry focuses primarily on evangelism. That is my gift. I was born in Catholicism, then I was a spiritualist, an occultist, a Mormon, a time with Jehovah Witnesses, an Adventist, and even evangelical, but all without being saved. I think that was the platform that God used in the future to be used for his glory. For this reason, the emphasis of my missionary report will always be the same, sharing with you the different places and opportunities that God gives me to teach the Gospel of Grace.

As always, brothers, we want to send you our deep gratitude for the generosity you have for the Lord and us, accompanying us with your prayers and offerings. Today, more than ever, they are a great blessing, considering the state of our country.

Please pray that the Lord will keep us faithful until He comes. Pray for His guidance and direction this year, both personally and in the ministry. Pray also that we will be strengthened by Him to continue the work.
