



Dear Pastors and Supporters,

All glory and honor goes to our God for all eternity. We are very grateful to God and to you, my dear brothers, for your continuous prayer on behalf of my family and the ministry that God has entrusted to me in this part of the Amazon of Peru. Please receive the greetings and gratitude from my family, Aladdin, Fe, Kerwin, and Jabes Abdiel.

Praise the Lord, we are in good health. My wife and I are serving the Lord both in the church and in the other towns where we preach the Word of God. This year, my eldest son is in his 3rd year of studying theological studies at the Baptist Seminary of Peru, in the city of Trujillo. My son, Jabes Abdiel, is in his 3rd year of studying primary education.

My family supports 5 young people of the ethnic group, Bora, who are developing their higher studies as nursing technicians. One of them, Vicky Ramos, already completed her studies last year. Thank God, they are all serving the Lord in the local church.

During this time of the year, many of our brothers who live in rural areas are suffering from losses in their homes due to flooding. Please pray for their needs to be met and for protection for their families and homes from the flooding.

Currently, we are developing ministries for children, youth, ladies, and men. We also have a missionary team that travels (when we have available funds) to teach the Word of God.

In the first week of January, the new work in San Pedro de Huashalado celebrated its third anniversary. God has greatly blessed this ministry, and we continue to pray for a full-time worker to serve in that place.

From February 6-11, we held the Apayacu 2024 Youth Camp. God greatly blessed us, and we were able to minister to approximately 180 campers. I had the help of our 4 young seminarians, which was truly a blessing. Seven people from the Philadelphia Church of Pevas were baptized, and two were baptized here in the city of Iquitos.

Let us share this blessing. Liwinson Soria is a teenager who participated in the Pucaurquillo Camp last year. He accepted Christ and shared with us the sad story of his parents' life. We prayed for his unsaved, unmarried parents. Liwinson lives outside the city. Last December, we went to visit him, and, through him, we reached out to his parents, for whom we had been praying. They had been separated from the Lord for 20 years. That morning, while I was ministering the Word of God, the





Holy Spirit convicted Liwinson's parents. They were reconciled, and they returned to the feet of the Savior. They were married last fall, and their son Liwinson has just been baptized. We praise God for this testimony of answered prayer in our ministry!

I would like to share a need with you all. As we were traveling to San Pedro de Marupa at the river crossing, we were caught in a storm with torrential rains. My work tools, which are my laptop and the image projector, got wet, and they stopped working. At this time I do not have these tools. Please pray that I will be able to replace these lost tools soon.
