It is a joy for us to be communicating again through our letter, informing you of our ministry in northern Argentina. We are very

grateful for your prayers and your financial support, which is a great help so that we can carry forward the gospel in the place where we are serving our Savior.

La Gracia Baptist Church (Tucuman) In the months of January and February, in Argentina, there are vacations and also very hot months, especially in the north. In our church, the activities centered on special days outdoors for the family, with teachings emphasizing the importance of the Bible in our home and camps for the family.





I want to ask for your prayers for a brother named Rene

Zurita. He is new to the faith and is growing a lot through discipleship. In spite of the fact that he is in a wheelchair, Rene is very faithful. I ask for your prayers, that Rene will have successful rehabilitation and be able to walk again.

Rosario de la Frontera Faith Baptist Church (Salta) The activities in Salta are a little different. We continue to strive in the construction of the church. We have already reached the height with the walls, and we have the structure in place where the roof will sit. We are

praying for the provision to be able to roof, but first we have to put in the windows and doors because of the strong winds that we have there. We are encouraged to move forward according to what the Lord is providing, and we rest in Him.

Regarding the believers, there is a new sister named Paola. She is coming to the church with her 2 children. They are not coming faithfully yet, but we are encouraging them and visiting them.

Native Peoples Ministries: In the first days of February, I traveled for 18 hours through the mountains and on very difficult roads to the community of Valle Colorado. There, I preached at the youth camps for 5 days to young people from different

aboriginal communities. They came from areas such as Caspala, Santana, Humahuaca, and Calilegua. 96 young people participated in the camp. 22 young people received the Lord as their personal savior, and 25 consecrated their lives to the Lord. We had an excellent time of games and walks through the mountains and, most importantly, the Word of God. I ask for your prayers for these communities, that the Lord will provide pastors to lead and missionaries who can help these people.







Brothers, thank you for your prayers. We always pray for you, your church, and your country. May the Lord bless you greatly.
