

AREQUIPA, FEBRUARY 2025

It is a blessing to be able to communicate once again with you, dear brothers and sisters. Thank you for your prayers and offerings. They have truly been a great help in the activities the Lord has allowed us to undertake, especially in the Christmas Evangelistic project. The Lord worked far beyond what we expected, as His Word says: "Now unto Him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power which worketh in us." (Ephesians 3:20)

In our limited plans, we intended to conduct two chocolate events, hoping to share 850 portions of chocolate with panettone (cake) and 550 toys with the children. However, by God's grace, we were able to hold 4 chocolate events where we witnessed the Lord's hand in the following ways:

- We held the first event on Sunday, December 7, in the Zone A of the Nueva Villa Ecológica Association: the Lord allowed us to share chocolate with approximately 790 people and give 380 gifts to the children. We shared the gospel with these people, and, as a result, 45 people expressed their decision for Christ, of which 28 were adults, 8 were children aged 7 to 10 years, and 9 were teenagers.
- We held the second event on Friday, December 13, especially for women: 149 women attended, and 13 of them expressed a decision for Christ.
- The third event was held on Saturday, December 14, and we focused on teenagers: 65 teenagers arrived, and 15 of them made a decision for Christ.
- Finally, we were able to hold our last chocolate event on December 22 at the church location. We shared the gospel with 386 people and distributed toys to 228 children. 28 people expressed their decision for Christ. On that same day, noticing that there was still chocolate and panettone left, one of the team members said, "Pastor, let's go to the bus stop where people wait to go home; let's take evangelistic brochures and distribute them along with the chocolate and panettone." God allowed us to share 80 portions of chocolate with panettone and to share gospel tracts with 80 more people.

In conclusion, the Lord allowed us to share the gospel with approximately 1,470 people, share 608 gifts with children, and 101 people declared their decision for Christ. All the glory be to our God.

FIRST SUMMER CAMP

After witnessing all the workings of the Lord during the Christmas season, God placed it in our hearts to organize the first camp to strengthen and encourage the lives of both new believers and those who regularly attend the church. We projected an attendance of around 35 campers, but God allowed us to have 46 campers from our church and 40 campers from other churches, for a total of 86 campers. Glory to God! It was a blessing to see how different brothers and sisters reaffirmed their commitment to follow and serve Christ.
