AFRICA MINISTRIES

Africa Baptist Bible Mission, Kenya

In December, the mission held a dedication service for Calvary Bible Baptist Church's new meeting place, Silale. After a year of fundraising and construction work, the Lord was pleased to allow us to pause and marvel at His work in our midst. Calvary Silale now has a beautiful property that we believe will be used for the glory of God for many years or until the return of our Saviour.

Umoia-Mbuvu Preaching Point

The Umoja-Mbuyu mission has grown so much over the last year. The mission has already secured a piece of land and is praying to be able to build a permanent home for the ever-growing congregation. The church has already begun raising funds locally, and so far, we have secured some of the needed construction materials. We are raising a total of \$18,380 for the construction of the auditorium and restrooms. We are appealing that you consider supporting this specific work as the Lord will enable you.

About Umoja-Mbuyu Area

This church is 25 km from Nyahururu town and is dominated by subsistence farmers and small business people. The majority of the settlers here are people who were previously displaced after the 2008 post-election violence. Over 400 families were settled here by the government and were only given land and a slight temporary house constructed for each family. The majority of these people lost everything they had owned to the tribal crashes that erupted in 2008. Please pray for the mission as they minister to these people and especially that the Word of God will bring about true peace in their hearts, as many have not recovered from the trauma of war and death that they witnessed.

1. Land purchase for Calvary Bible Baptist Church Leshau. The need is at \$4,364.

- 3. Classroom Completion at BBC Nyahururu for \$5,000.

Bible school

Our Bible School is gradually growing. Keep praying for God to touch the hearts of men and women to come and learn His Word. We will be resuming classes soon.

2024 in retrospect

The Lord blessed the mission in the past year as their collective efforts brought 492 souls to faith in Christ, with 52 following the Lord in Baptism. They had 42 students studying at their Bible College, with 24 graduating. Their current enrollment stands at 34. The Christian School program enrolled close to 300 pupils. Holding weekly worship services and sharing the Gospel message with these children was a blessing. Our Sunday Schools and Youth Clubs saw over 500 children enrolling.

Family retreat at Doboro

On January 11, the mission held a Family Retreat program for their churches in the Greater Accra and Central Regions, hosted by the Campus Church at Ankwa Doboro. They had nearly 200 people attending, which was a blessing to the families. Since Covid 19, this was the second time the mission has organized its regular Family Retreat program.

Graduate module resumes at SRBBC

Classes have been ongoing for the graduate students at Solid Rock Baptist Bible College and Seminary since January 20. Dr. Ben Epton, Pastor of Berea Baptist Church in Takoradi and a graduate of our college, has been the resource person throughout this week, taking our students through Leadership in Worship.
