Dear friends and partners in the ministry of our Savior, Jesus Christ,

I am glad to write this first update of 2025. My prayer is that this letter finds you well in the Lord.

We ended the year 2024 on a blessed note. We had a successful youth camp and a glorious VBS for our children. Our teachers and church members worked so hard to make each event a memorable reality to our young people and a great service to our Savior.

In December, we held a dedication service for the new meeting place for Calvary Bible Baptist Church, Silale. After a year of fundraising and construction work, the Lord was pleased to allow us to pause and marvel at His work in our midst. Calvary Silale now has a beautiful property that we believe will be used for the glory of God for many years, or until the return of our Savior.

Umoja-Mbuyu Preaching Point

As earlier reported, our Umoja-Mbuyu mission has grown so much over the last year. We already secured a piece of land and are praying to be able to build a permanent home for the ever-growing congregation. The church has already begun raising funds locally, and, so far, we have secured some of the needed construction materials. We are raising a total of \$18,380 for the construction works for the auditorium and restrooms. We are appealing that you consider supporting this specific work as the Lord will enable you.

About Umoja-Mbuyu Area

This church is located 25 km from Nyahururu town and is dominated by subsistence farmers and small business people. The majority of the settlers here are people who were previously displaced after the 2008 post-election violence. Over 400 families were settled here by the government and only given land and a small temporary house constructed for each family. The majority of these people lost everything they had owned to the tribal crashes that erupted in 2008. Here in Mbuyu, many are now settling down after what felt like a lifetime of misery in this foreign land. Today we thank God that many are able to gather in churches for worship. We now have two churches among the IDPs (Internally Displaced Persons), and Umoja-Mbuyu is the newest. Please pray for us as we minister to these people and especially that the Word of God will bring about true peace in their hearts as many have not recovered from the trauma of war and death that they witnessed.
