Upcoming Youth Retreat:

We are excited to announce our upcoming youth retreat at the end of February, where we will welcome 300 campers from our church and the surrounding communities. This retreat is a significant event in the lives of our young people, offering them a space to grow spiritually, connect with one another, and deepen their faith in Christ. We have a special speaker and his newlywed wife coming, a young pastor who is eager to share the message of God's love and truth through worship, teaching, and fellowship. Please pray for the safety and hearts of all the campers, as well as for the leaders and volunteers who will be guiding and serving throughout the weekend. The Good Shepherd Clinic has been a vital resource in our community, and we are thankful for the opportunity to serve those in need of medical care. Over the past months, we have seen a steady increase in the number of patients seeking treatment, particularly in the areas of lab testing and chronic disease management. With your support, we are able to provide essential medical services, often to individuals who would otherwise go without. We continue to train our staff and volunteers to provide compassionate, professional care to all. We were recently able to replace the old backless wooden benches in our waiting area with newly welded iron benches with backs. We also expanded our laboratory so that our technicians can more efficiently process the demand of lab tests daily. Thank you for your prayers for health and healing for those we serve!
