#### **Christmas Outreach Service**

On December 22, our church hosted a Christmas Outreach Service, and it was nothing short of a tremendous blessing! The event brought together over 300 people, including nearly 250 Deaf individuals, many of whom were accompanied by their hearing children. It was heartwarming to see the faithful dedication of about 30 church members, who went above and beyond to invite attendees and ensure everyone felt welcome and cared for. Despite the challenge of navigating such a large crowd, everything flowed smoothly, allowing us to share the life-transforming message of the Gospel with so many.

A special highlight of the day was the ministry to children. Hannah and my daughter, Rebecca, lovingly cared for 46 children throughout the service, giving them an opportunity to experience the love of Christ in a meaningful way.

Another incredible testimony of God's work came from a group of 10 Deaf individuals who traveled all the way from Jharkhand, a neighboring state, to attend the event. Their journey was inspiring. They left their town on a Saturday evening, boarded a train at 7:30 PM, and arrived at our church early Sunday morning, around 8:30 AM. Despite having never met us before, they accepted our invitation, which had been shared with them through WhatsApp.

Hearing their stories was truly humbling. Some expressed a deep desire to learn more about Jesus and shared how their small group of about 30 Deaf individuals in Jharkhand gathers regularly for fellowship but lacks a teacher to guide them in Bible study. We were overjoyed to provide them with Gospel tracts, share information about our ministry's website, and introduce them to our YouTube Live sessions, which we distribute via our WhatsApp Bible Teaching group. I also joined their group to personally share sermons, Bible teachings, and extend invitations to future events. Their excitement and eagerness were contagious, and they even shared plans to bring more Deaf individuals to our Easter Outreach Service on April 20th!

Please join us in praying for this group and the incredible work God is doing among them. We are grateful for the opportunity to partner with Him in reaching more people with the hope of the Gospel.
