Missions:


During the month of April, I travelled to Liberia to participate in the dedication of the Great Commission Fundamental Baptist Church's new sanctuary. I was there with Dr. Kevin Callahan, the President of IPM. We also had the opportunity to visit some of their church plants.

I was privileged to preach at the Berean Baptist Church, Lartebiokorshie, on April 20, 2025, and at the Truth Missionary Baptist Church, Dansoman, on Sunday, April 27, 2025. I served the Lord's Supper in the latter.

AFRICA MINISTRIES Solid Rock Baptist Mission, Ghana Church Leader Passes Away

For a week in March, the mission workers were in the village of Droboso to take part in a funeral for the late Mr. Ebenezer Otchere. He had provided leadership for Solid Rock Baptist Church of Droboso, in the Ashanti region, until the church got its trained pastor. Pastors Emmanuel and Samuel Appiah, both labouring in the Bono East Region, came to lend a hand. The Campus Church at Doboro also sent a strong delegation to assist with the service. Pastor Appiah preached at the service, while Pastor Damuah did the committal.

On Sunday, Rev. Dr. Dapaah preached at the Thanksgiving service and rejoiced to see many pray to receive Christ as Savior. There was a good gospel witness during the funeral services, and we praise God.

Church Planting

This year, the mission does not intend to start a new church, but work hard to help the last four churches they have begun, strengthening them. The Tamale Fellowship especially needs attention. For the second time, they have been kicked out of the classroom where they normally hold services.

Ethiopia Ministry

The work of the Lord continues in Debre Birhan and the surrounding areas.

We thank God for His grace and love, which help us reach our community. We hold daily evangelism events to distribute our evangelistic literature and booklets. From January to the present, we have distributed 130 pieces of evangelistic literature and made contacts.

Our contacts were encouraging, and we have seen four people repent of their sins and trust the Lord for their salvation. Five people are following discipleship lessons and are being prepared for future baptism. We also have 13 members learning advanced discipleship lessons.

Chad Ministry

2024 END OF YEAR ACTIVITIES- Children's Sunday School Teacher Training:

Sunday school teachers were given special training on two occasions to enable them to work with kids.

Deaf Leaders' Meeting

In the second half of September, Deaf School Leaders met in Walia for Bible teaching to reinforce their Christian faith. The Mission Director conducted a Bible study on the book of James. Walia is on the outskirts of N'Djamena, the capital of Chad.

Training for Church Planters and Missionaries

In December, the mission held two weeks of intensive training at Koubala, an Evangelical Reception Center. This was planned to add more service skills to the ministry in churches. Many people attended that training.

Mission Baptiste Fundamentale (MBI) Ivory Coast:

The mission wants to thank the Lord for the good health of the Bible school Director and his family, and is also grateful to God for training the Bible Institute students.

Currently, the institute has 15 students and three teachers.

Deaf Ministry:

The mission is grateful to the Lord for the missionary in charge of the deaf ministry and his entire family for the great work among the deaf. In the first quarter, five new deaf people joined the deaf community and worshiped with them.

Two of the five have professed salvation, including a young deaf person from a Muslim family. Seven deaf people have been prepared for baptism. Please pray for them.

On Sunday, April 20, during the Easter celebration, Missionary Bro. Leonce and his wife accepted a young orphaned deaf girl into their home, bringing the total number of deaf people under their care to 6.
