

Good morning, my dear brothers and sisters,

Thank you very much for your prayers and financial support so we can continue preaching the gospel in this part of the Peruvian Amazon.

Praise the Lord, our family is currently in good health after all of us have been ill. Our healing reminded us of the powerful hand of our great God. We are grateful to Him.

As a church, we continue praying and participating in missionary work, training and sending workers to the mission field. We continue spreading the good news of salvation and planting churches in the Amazon. One of these is the Maranatha Church in the Puerto Rico community of Barranquilla, which, due to natural disasters, is currently flooded. As a result, construction has not been completed.

In April, classes began at the Libertad Perú Theological Seminary, with 23 students training to better understand the Lord and thus be able to love Him and obey His commands.

In May, we received a visit from Dr. Bill Brown and Rebecca International. During their visit, we traveled to three towns, bringing the gospel of Jesus Christ and medicine for health care. The towns were Triunfo de Río Amazonas, Cabo Pantoja, and San Pedro de Huashalado. From May 20-27, I visited Huanta, Apayacu, San Agusto, and Yanayacu. I was able to see the great need and suffering the faithful are experiencing as a result of the floods, which inundated all their crops, their only source of income. For this reason, we are promoting fundraising efforts to provide the Christians there with food. This is pleasing to the Lord.

On June 18th, I will be traveling with seminary students to the Baptist Church Convention in the Bora community of Pucaurquillo, where I will be preaching for three days.

From August 30th to September 3rd, the San Pedro de Huashalado 2025 Youth Camp will be held, for which I ask for your prayers for the glory of God.
