By His grace, the Lord provided for this great project, and we dedicated the church to the Lord on April 12, 2025. OUTREACH

As the Great Commission is the heartbeat of God, we have made it our business to reach out to people who would not normally come to church. This quarter, 33 people acknowledged Christ as their Lord and Savior, and 15 others rededicated their lives, after leaving church for a year. Let's pray with these people to have a desire to commit themselves to the service of God.



VILLAGE CHURCH

By the grace of God, Pastor Gaye and Deacon Barlea established the Great Commission Fundamental Baptist Church in Flompa in July, 2023. Since then, Deacon Barlea has been pastoring the church up to the present. This quarter, 26 souls got saved, and 1 person rededicated his life to Christ. This church is situated in a town with a population of 8,000. In the future, we will need two acres of land for the church building, but at present, we are trusting the Lord to provide us with \$900 for a temporary worship center.

A sum of 59 souls got saved, and 16 people rededicated their lives.

YOUTH CAMP

The future of any ministry is the presence of young people. The Great Commission Fundamental Baptist Mission is decided to invest more time and effort into the youth ministry. In view of this, we will be holding a youth camp this summer. We are trusting the Lord to house 80 young people, along with 10 leaders. For the success of this meeting, we pray for the Lord's provision of \$1,500. Each camper will pay \$10 for the four days, but this amount can not supply all that is needed per person for the four days.



CHRISTIAN FOUNDATION HIGH SCHOOL
