#### Children's Sunday School

The teachers received training so they are better prepared to serve the Lord. The children continue to learn and are challenged to follow Jesus. We have a good number of teachers, which makes it easier for them to rotate and participate in Sunday meetings.



# **OANSA Children's Ministry**

In this ministry, the brothers and sisters are very motivated to reach the children. One of the sisters involved in the children's ministry, who lives far away, began bringing children from her neighborhood so they could know Jesus and learn of His love. We are very happy to see the hand of God working both in the children and the teachers.



### Youth Ministry

With the young people, we are now learning topics of Christian living, so they may have knowledge of how to please the Lord and live lives that give Him glory.



#### Women's Ministry

The sisters continue to learn from the Old Testament how God reveals Himself to humanity. They are greatly challenged in their knowledge of the Bible.



#### Marriage Ministry

In marriage meetings, we are teaching how to resolve conflicts and emerge victorious in submission to the Lord. We have a new couple who are attending church with great enthusiasm.



## Anocaraire Church Ministry

The church in Anocaraire is very motivated to serve God. They held a camp for teenagers and another for children, which greatly encouraged the faithful. We pray that the two young men preparing for theological studies can serve in the church full-time.

### **Missions**

Our missionary, Silvia, continues with the ministry of bringing the gospel to people in jungle communities. This time was difficult because gasoline is very scarce in our country, and they













couldn't get fuel for the canoe's motor. Thank God they were finally able to get enough gasoline to reach some places and deliver clothes, food, and the gospel.

Missionary Elizabeth is serving in Oromomo. There are no doctors there, and one of the men there fractured his foot and had to be taken out by plane for treatment. He is better now. Elizabeth continues serving with children and women in this community.

#### **Omereque Project**

The Jaimes family had to come to Cochabamba due to health issues for their son, Timoteo. He was hospitalized for a week, and then their other son also fell ill. They went through a very difficult time, but God strengthened them through the love of their brothers and sisters, and now they are preparing to return home.

We are receiving training to preach the gospel to people in universities, schools, and neighborhoods, and we had an outing with children from an orphanage.
