Family Update

My wife, son, daughter, and I are currently in Lima, the capital city of Peru. We have been here for the past seven days, awaiting my wife's pacemaker checkup on the 25th of this month. At the moment, my wife is in somewhat poor health. The extreme cold in Lima is causing her bone pain, headaches, and high blood pressure. It has been stable for a few days, but we trust that the Lord will grant us healing.

We very much need your prayers, that my wife does not have any complications, so that we can return to home.

We thank all the brothers who are praying for my wife's health. We are grateful for the financial support received.

Ministry Update

In the month of May, my daughters, Martha, and Joysi, taught the children in the Sunday school at our church. The children are attending very regularly. We ask for your prayers for my daughters as they continue teaching the children.

In the month of June, we had two large events. First, on June 12th, we evangelized more than 200 people with disabilities, where many reconciliations and decisions were made. This event was held in the maloca of the Catholic church. We ask for your prayers for those who heard the gospel at this event.

The second event was held on June 24th. General evangelism was held with more than 150 people, including children and adults, where many people heard the gospel message. We also need your prayers for the Lord to open doors to hold many more events.
