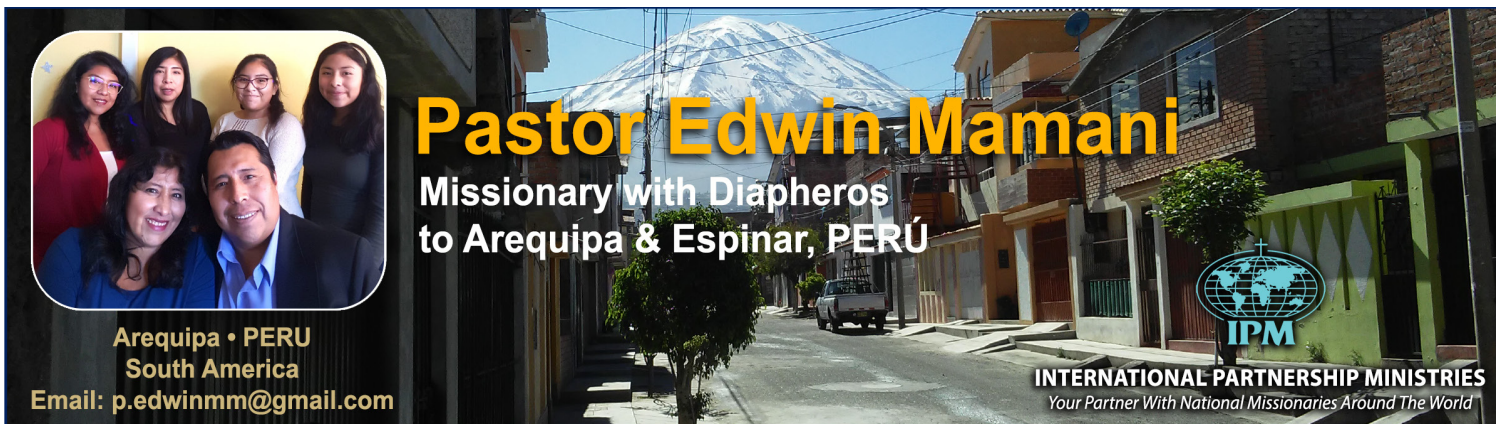




OCTOBER 2025

We greet you in the precious name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. God is always faithful and gives growth according to His will.

We appreciate your prayers for the church's anniversary. The Lord has allowed us to celebrate our 4th anniversary. The theme we chose for this event was "A SPECIAL TREASURE." We held different activities every Sunday in September, with children, women, and teenagers participating. The goal was to value salvation and the communion we can enjoy through it as children of God. We had wonderful gatherings with an average of 80 to 90 people in each program, and on the main day we reached up to 110 people. The most important thing is that through these activities, 4 people accepted Christ as Savior: two women (Claridad and Yovana) and two teenagers (Kevin and Kiara).

The Lord continued working, and this October, He allowed a medical campaign to be carried out with a team from the United States. Nearly 150 people were treated, but the most special thing is that we were able to share the gospel with them, and 51 people accepted Christ as their Savior. Glory to God!

I ask for your prayers for all these decisions, that the seed of the Word planted in their hearts may continue to grow.

Finally, dear brothers and sisters, we are already beginning everything related to the Christmas evangelistic project "ONE STEP MORE." As you know, each year we go to a different area, bringing chocolate, panettone (a typical cake of the Christmas season), gifts for children, but above all, we spread the gospel of Christ. Last year, by the grace of God and the financial support of our brothers and sisters in Christ, we were able to share 1,400 servings of chocolate and panettone. This means that 1,400 people were able to hear the message of salvation, and 580 children from low-income families were able to receive a gift. This year we are considering going to Zone "A" of the San Luis Gonzaga Association on Saturday, December 13th, and we think we'll have the same number of people (although the Lord always surprises us). To cover the cost of the ingredients for the hot chocolate and panettone, we need approximately \$1,600, and to buy toys for the children, we are considering a cost of \$6 per toy.

Prayer Requests:

1. I ask for your prayers for the financial needs of the "**Un Paso Más (One Step More)**" Christmas evangelistic project. May the Lord open doors for us so we can have what we need during the remainder of October and November to make the purchases as soon as possible, as costs increase as the Christmas season approaches.

2. **For a generator.** Perhaps some of the photos you see are dark, because the church is located in an area where community electricity is used. When other people don't pay, they cut off the service, affecting us all. These outages have often affected church programs. To purchase a generator, we need approximately \$800.

Thank you in advance for your prayers, as well as your financial contributions to our ministry and to my family.
