We greet you in the love of the Lord from the city of Apatzingán, Michoacán. We hope that God's blessings are with you. In the mission field where we are located, we strive to be faithful in preaching the gospel of Christ. Thank you for being part of our ministry.

On August 11-15, we held our summer Bible school. It is always a blessing to be able to joyfully hold the summer little Bible school. Several members participated, serving as teachers, others as assistants, some children from our church as students, and children who do not attend church but whom we desire to reach for Christ. We are grateful to God for this activity, as we were able to minister the gospel of Christ to a large group of children. Additionally, through this event, we were able to minister to the parents of some of the children. Finally, on the last day, first, second, and third place were chosen from among the children's different classes. As winners, they are allowed to be first to choose from gifts that we place on tables. Although the gifts are small, all of the children enjoy this moment.

Thank God, in September, the Chávez Rangel family left for the city of Uruapan, Michoacán, to fulfill God's calling. Since he began taking classes at the Bible Institute, Brother Rangel had the idea of starting a ministry in that city, so we prayed about it. He graduated from the institute, got married, and for about 5 years now, his wife and he have been serving in our church. This family believes that God has called them to preach the gospel in the city of Uruapan, Michoacán, so they left for that city with the goal of starting a church. It was a great blessing as some members of our church, my wife, and I came to support the opening service at the mission. At the end, we enjoyed a delicious dish called "morisqueta."



We continued with the construction on the church grounds. For various reasons, we are building slowly, but we pray to God to finish the roof so we can begin worship services there.



Every Tuesday, some of us brothers come to the city center to speak to souls about



salvation. Thank God, we are almost always able to share the gospel with different people. Sometimes we team up to hold a Bible club to reach children for Christ. I personally visit some contacts, including Javier, a businessman, Sergio, a locksmith, and German, a veterinarian. I visit them sometimes because they have made a profession of faith or simply because they sympathize with the Word of God. The purpose of visiting them is to reach them for Christ, make disciples, or invite them to church. We also visit some members of the church to make disciples and help them in their spiritual growth.
