We are thankful to God for His blessings in the ministry and to our family. Thank you all for your prayers, which impact the events of our ministry and make them possible as we spread Jesus' testimony.

Preaching Station Shelter Repairs

Due to weather, the rough materials that were used to cover the roofs have become too soft to resist the sun's heat, the wind, and rain water. All these combined together have made the roofs brittle, putting stress on the timbers of the walls and the thatch used to cover the roof and walls. These rough materials only last for two or three years, and after that they are worm-eaten and collapse. One of Sarh preaching points and Bebedjia shelters have been repaired.

Bebedjia Church

Some of the members are sick most of the time even though they take medicine. We organized one week of prayer and fasting to ask for God's mercy. Thanks to God, two girls and one lady have been healthy for almost one month.

Inclusive Camp Joy

Our most recent Inclusive Camp Joy took place at Evangelical Church No. 8 in Moundou in mid-September. (Moundou is where our deaf brothers have their services. We are grateful that this church had enough space for our outside games.)

Counselors were trained from September 12-14, to take care of small groups. The general camp started on the 15th and ended on the 20th. It included both hearing and non-hearing young people. Non-hearing came from the North, where their Deaf School is located. Many of them did not know that we existed. One of them asked for the next Inclusive Camp Joy to take place in their city. I am planning this, by the will of God, for two years from now. A different village is already planned for next year.

As I preached, the teens were surprised to learn that all of the sin trends of nowadays are not new, (such as lust and alcohol dependence), and that God has reprimanded this in the Bible since the beginning of time. Pray for these teens, that they will be saved, grow in their Christian lives, and be able to resist the temptations of sin. For games, due to lack of team shirts, we use different colored head wrapping ribbons, to make distinction between teams.
