Greetings in the name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. We are deeply grateful for your prayers and financial support, which enable us to serve the Lord faithfully in Liberia.

## **Troy Family**

By God's grace, we continue to serve despite numerous challenges. The Lord has been faithful in meeting our needs (Matt. 6:33; 1 Pet. 5:7).

Regarding my health, I am thankful the fever has subsided, though I still experience dizziness. The doctor has recommended additional tests, which will cost approximately \$700. I am trusting God for His provision. Despite this, I remain committed to my pastoral duties, knowing my time to serve is in the Lord's hands.

## **Transportation**

One of my greatest challenges is transportation. My vehicle is no longer functional, as it is unable to exceed 30 MPH despite extensive repairs. I am praying for a double-cabin, four-door pickup truck costing \$10,000 to support the ministry's needs. God has provided \$1,000, and I trust Him for the remaining \$9,000.

#### Church

Since the opening of our new church building, the congregation has been growing steadily. Despite transportation challenges in this new community, members and local residents are attending in increasing numbers. Our new converts' class, children's and adult Sunday schools, and women's classes are thriving. Please pray for their spiritual growth and active involvement in church activities.





# Outreach

Great Commission Baptist Church is actively engaged in outreach, including community programs and children's events. We are working to establish a new church to reach the unreached and backsliders. During a recent visit to this new preaching station, five people accepted Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior, and others rededicated their lives to Him. The group is currently seeking a permanent worship space. Please pray for their spiritual understanding as the Word of God is shared.

# Special Teaching: The Lord's Supper

In the town of Duo, several churches gather monthly for the Lord's Supper, often without a trained pastor to administer it. This led to confusion and questions. By God's grace, I was invited to teach. Over two days, we studied Scripture, addressing doubts and misunderstandings. The leaders then requested monthly Bible training for laypeople, with 25 individuals from eight churches expressing interest. Please pray for this initiative, as it requires resources for transportation, Bible lessons, and printed materials. Your prayer and financial support is vital for this costly but worthy call.



## **School Evangelism**

In my city of 50,000, with over 90 schools, the Bible is no longer taught in public or community schools. I feel burdened to share God's Word during school assemblies, especially as the youth face dangers from accidents and illegal drugs. Pray for open doors and effective outreach.

#### **Camp Ministry**

I have a strong burden to engage young people with God's Word, as many are losing interest in spiritual matters and focusing on material pursuits. To address this, we plan to host a youth camp by the end of the year.

The camp requires \$1,900 for transportation, food, and lodging, as many families cannot afford to contribute.

Please pray for the provision and success of this life-changing event.

# **Deaf Ministry**

The deaf community in our church is remarkably loving and caring, often surpassing even our hearing members in their devotion. Under Pastor Gaye's leadership in academics and Pastor Zuo's pastoral care, this ministry is growing rapidly. A few months ago, eight individuals were baptized, and many are now attending the new converts' class.

Friends are providing lodging and food for this group, but they also need support for basic necessities, such as medicines and clothing. Please pray for their continued growth and provision.

#### **Christian Foundation School**

We are deeply thankful for your prayers and support, which enabled us to successfully complete the last academic year. We have begun the 2025-2026 school year, trusting the Lord for this journey. Our doors are open for assistance, including teachers for mathematics and science, or financial support to sustain this ministry.
