Dear brothers and sisters,

November 2025

It is a joy for us to communicate with you again. We pray that the Lord is blessing you as always. And today, more than ever, we have hope that the Lord will soon come to take His church. For this reason, and more than ever, we must be preaching the glorious gospel of eternal life.

I received an invitation to continue teaching the same subjects next year. They added another subject: Evangelism with paintings. The idea is to teach the subject and then go out with the students to evangelize in public places, such as a park, a plaza, or a pedestrian street where many people pass by.

By the grace of God, this is the fourth Bible institute where I have the privilege of teaching the evangelism course. Glory to God!

In October, I was invited to give an evangelism workshop at the Jorge Hotton School in Zárate. About fifty young people between the ages of 18 and 25 participated. In November, I was in Lima, Peru, invited to the church where I had served as pastor for six years. The reason for the invitation was that Halloween is celebrated in Argentina in November. And because of my past involvement in the occult and spiritualism, I was invited to speak on that very topic.

Brothers and sisters, I want to share my joy for a brother named Nestor, who attended one of my seminaries a few years ago. He is a young man with the gift of evangelism. He is Argentinian, but now he is a pastor in Colorado, USA. The following is some of what he told me: "Miguel, a group of older young people asked me to lead an evangelism workshop, and of the 17 who took the course, 14 made a decision for Christ."

Another: "Hi Miguel, these are the people with whom we had the evangelism workshop, and the four women on the right made a decision for Christ".

The first woman, the one in the black dress, is Nestor's wife; she is also Argentinian.

Another one: "Hi Miguel, they received Christ today. I used your pamphlet to preach to them, (the one the man is holding)".

Nestor likes all my pamphlets, and he asked if he could have the PDF of one. Now Nestor is printing three of my pamphlets, for now in Spanish, but he has already started translating them into English. If any brother would like to have them in his churches, I can send him his cell phone number and we can talk directly to him.



Brothers and sisters, in a previous letter I mentioned three websites I have: one Mormon and two Jehovah's Witnesses. People from many countries visit them, and I ask you to pray for those who visit the site. Recently, I've had the opportunity to speak with many Mormon elders. They are facing a great struggle. There were times when it seemed they might convert, but they find it difficult to leave the sect. Five of them are currently engaged in a great spiritual battle. The timing of salvation is the work of the Holy Spirit; He knows what will happen to them in the future.

The great thing about all this is that people from many countries visit the website. A few days ago, I received a letter from a pastor in Kenya. He told me that the website has been a great blessing to him and his congregation. Below is the letter he sent me:

"Hallelujah. Praise the living God. I hope this message finds you well. I wanted to express my deep appreciation for the inspiring work of your church ministry, which I have been following online. The teachings and spiritual guidance you provide have had a profound impact on my life and the lives of my church members.
