On September 24, we held the celebration of the annual men's retreat, where Pastor Raymundo Cedano was the guest speaker. He is part of the group of teachers in our Bible Institute ministry.

On September 27, we held the annual Bible conference, where Dr. Tom Wolfe, from IPM Education Department, was the guest speaker. We had almost two hundred people in attendance. Among them, we had twelve pastors from different cities, towns and villages.

On September 29 to October 3, we were challenged through an intensive Bible modular course on 1st Thessalonians. The theme was "Growing a



Church With Godly Goals." As a result of this wonderful time, some of the pastors are considering holding a modular course in their areas, due to the distance.

On October 5, I traveled to the Bávaro area to preach, morning and evening, and discuss plans related to training more men for the ministry of preaching and teaching.



On November 16, we are planning to celebrate the annual regional gathering of churches. Churches from different places are planning to come.

On November 22, Lord willing, we will hold the annual pastors meeting in Santo Domingo.

On November 26, we will be traveling to Higüey for a special conference, where I will be the guest speaker.

On January 21, we are scheduled to have the annual men's meeting in the City of Consuelo, 30 miles southwest from El Seibo.
