



Remembering the Faithful Martyrs of the Spanish Inquisition

It was October 8, 1558. The city of Valladolid, capital of the Spanish empire at that time, was ready for a big event presided over by King Philip II, an Auto de Fe, intended for the "purifying" of the Catholic Church of all those persons considered heretics by it. Their only crime was their faith in Christ as the only means of salvation. In order to remember the courage of these brethren of the past, we brought back the last hours of one of these martyrs, don Carlos de Seso, a nobleman who died at the stake for his faith that day. The night before, don Carlos was allowed to write his testimony, which turned to be a complaint against the errors of the Catholic Church and a confession that his only hope of salvation and eternal life was in Jesus, his only Savior. At the end of the representation the members of the choir sang this inspiring hymn:

"Are ye able," said the Master, "To be crucified with me?" "Yea," the sturdy dreamers answered, "To the death we follow Thee."
