Dear Friends in Christ,

January 2026

We bring you New Year greetings and thank you so much for your support and prayers which enables us to do the Lord's ministry.

The last quarter of the year 2025 turned out to be quite eventful. On August 26, we picked up our passports from the US consular office, expecting the usual five-year multiple entry visa renewal, only to realize that we had been given a three-month single-entry visa dated back in July and expiring in October. Technically we had two months left for the visas to expire. It was not negotiable. So, we placed our work schedule on hold and travelled to the US on September 12. We got in touch with some supporting churches, mostly on the East Coast and Mid-West and got meetings lined up from the last week of September to the first Sunday in December.

We visited thirteen states and spoke in about 22 churches including two missions' conferences. Our gratitude to all our supporting Pastors who gave us the opportunity on very short notice.

We returned from the trip on December 11. On December 13, I officiated a wedding at Tema, Solid Rock Baptist Church, and another wedding was waiting for me on December 21 at the Campus Church at Ankwa Doboro. On December 28, I presided over the induction of four Pastors at the Tema Church.

## TAMALE OUTREACH UPDATE

Some missionary friends visited the Tamale outreach and took note of the people holding services under a tree. They were moved to help the church to acquire a plot on which we could raise a tabernacle for a place of worship. Thanks for praying. Keep praying that God provides for the building also. Praise the Lord.

## SRBBC

We are in the process of divesting our college courses to include training in other employable skills such as Nursing Training, Computer Science, Education, and others. We are also approaching the accreditation body in charge of Tertiary institutions to seek accreditation for our college, so that the diplomas and certificates we issue here will be recognized universally.

It has become necessary to pursue this path because young men who are interested in serving the Lord are reluctant to attend a college whose certificates are not recognized. Expanding our programs with accreditation will also attract more students and lead to the college becoming a self-supporting institution.

A preliminary inspection has been done, and recommendations have been made including the completion of the second floor of our Multipurpose building, which is currently hosting our library and administration.

Our library is going to install the internet and add computers so that students are not limited to books in the library but be able to go online to do research.





An Information Communication Technology ( I.C.T) Center is to be set up to enhance training in Computer Science and Information Technology.

**2025 IN RETROSPECT**

Our collective efforts brought 644 to faith in Christ, and 58 followed the Lord in believers' baptism. Our youth clubs and Sunday Schools enrolled 540 children with 57 youth leaders. Our Christian Two School enrolled 281 students with 36 staff members.
