Dear Brothers and Sisters,

January 2026

I thank God for all of you. Truly, you have been a blessing to our family and ministry. After founding two churches in Mexico and establishing the leaders, we finally returned to our country, Chile, on January 5th, where we had already founded three churches. We returned with the goal of continuing the missionary work. Here is a picture of the church we left in Puebla.



We know it won't be easy to continue the missionary work with my wife being so limited, but she is always willing to serve in whatever way she can. Life here is more expensive than in Mexico. A good example is that the rent for a house we have already seen and reserved is \$950. We are trusting in God's provision, knowing that He has never abandoned us. The good news is that in Santiago, Chile, there are about 20 brothers and sisters without a pastor, and they have already asked me for help to minister to them, teach them how to evangelize, and together go out to evangelize those without Christ. I am already invited to share special studies with them in March and take charge of them.



On this trip, I am accompanied by two daughters, Priscilla and Myrle, and my son, Joel, and Alex, one of my sons-in-law, who served in a church in Guatemala for more than 10 years. My daughter Priscilla, her husband Alex, and my son all have theological studies and much experience in sharing the Word of God. We hope to be a great blessing to the missions and churches here in Chile.

CUBA

Thanks be to God that on my last trip to Cuba with Brother Matheo from IPM, on November 28, 2025, we managed to complete several projects in Cuba. We bought 4 bicycles, 3 complete sets of bathroom fixtures for three house churches, two lithium batteries for house churches, a water pump for a church that had a well, and gave a special offering to dig a well in another house church. We also left a special offering of \$1800 to buy a house church and another offering to finish some classrooms for children, among many other projects. Here I share some images of the trip and some of the projects we completed in Cuba.

We still need to buy all the kitchen utensils, a dining room set, and several other pieces of furniture.
