Dear Pastor and Church,

Greetings, dear brothers and sisters, and blessings in this new year. We give thanks that the Lord gives us life so that we can continue to be useful in His work. Once again, through this letter, we want to share with you about our ministry in Northern Argentina and also thank you for your prayers and financial support. You are our partner in advancing the vision that God has placed in our lives; we are always grateful for what God provides.

La Gracia Baptist Church (Tucuman) In January and February, it is summer. These are the months when families and members of the church go on vacation, generally to visit relatives who live in other states. During these months, as a church, we focus on camps and retreats for families, young people, and children. In these past months, God has blessed us in the activities we carried out, and by His grace, we had nine souls saved and several people who came for the first time to the church retreats. We conducted these activities with the Ebenezer Baptist Church in Metán, Salta, and the Faith Baptist Church in Rosario de la Frontera, Salta.

We organized the retreats in tents since the location is rural. I ask for your prayers for those who came for the first time and for the decisions they made based on the messages preached: Cristina Ibarra, Abigail, Jhoana, Gerardo, and Claudia Pintos (who came with their four children), and Marcelo Aguirre. We pray that God will work in their hearts.

Brothers and sisters, I want to ask for your prayers for José Martín Velardez. He is a doctor who came to our church with his family. He has biblical knowledge, but he is not saved and is very confused by charismatic doctrine. Please pray that God will guide him to all truth.

FE Baptist Church (Rosario de La Frontera), as we mentioned before, is currently on vacation, so we have been focused on camps and retreats with the churches that were mentioned.

We want to thank you for your prayers and financial support for the construction of the church building. We have already been able to put on the roof and install the doors and windows. Glory to the Lord! We have made tremendous progress. There is truly great joy in our hearts to see how God works when there is enthusiasm and vision among the brothers and sisters and the church. I am sharing photos of the completed roof in the hall and the windows and doors that have already been installed.

Now we are working on the flooring and the interior plastering of the hall. We trust in the provision of our Savior.





Regarding the trips to the churches in the mountains and indigenous communities, we were unable to go as planned in October due to a lack of resources and a suitable vehicle. Because of the condition of the roads, we need a 4x4 truck so that we can also transport aid to the brothers and sisters who live in the Puna and the Valleys, which are very remote areas. Please help us with your prayers so we can move forward in these ministries.

Brothers and sisters, thank you for taking the time to read our letter, and thank you for your prayers; we pray for you, your country, and your churches.



A special prayer request is for our family. We have had frequent storms since December, and the roof of our house has many leaks. We tried to repair it, but it's beyond repair, and we need to replace it. My family and I are working to raise the money; we have already collected \$500 and still need \$1,300. We trust in God's provision.

- For our health, that the Lord would give us strength to continue serving. I am still having stomach problems, but I trust that I will recover.
- For our sustenance. We are not able to cover our budget, but we are very grateful for what we receive, which is a great help.
- For the interior plastering of the church - \$1,300
- For the floor repairs - \$1,300
- Tires for our car - \$400.
