Faith Independent Baptist Church

From January 6-12, we organized Spiritual Emphasis with Fasting and Prayers for the whole church to motivate them for service ahead. We also organized a two-day prayer and fasting section to build up our leaders and motivate them for service. We currently have five persons willing to follow the Lord in believers' baptism by the end of March. Other opportunities

I was privileged to chair the ordination council that examined Pastor Peter Baah of the Dansoman Baptist Church for his ordination. I also preached at that same church on the second Sunday of January, 2026.

I also spoke at the second anniversary of the home calling of Rev. Dr. Abraham Nakom and his wife. Rev. Nakom is the founder of the Ghana Inland Mission, which has planted many fundamental Independent Baptist Churches in the Sege area.

I traveled to the Ivory Coast from December 12-15, 2025, for the Bible School graduation. The graduation came off on December 13 at 9 am. I was the guest of honour for the occasion. I was tasked with handing out the diplomas to the graduates.

I also gave the Biblical charge. On Sunday, December 14, 2025, I preached at the Sunday Morning service at the Mission Port-Bouet 2 church.

On Monday, December 15, I gave a lecture on the theme, "Missions and Evangelism," to twenty MBF missionaries. On Tuesday, December 16, I addressed minor issues involving some leaders. Disagreements were amicably resolved.

TAMALE OUTREACH UPDATE

Some missionary friends visited the Tamale outreach and noticed the people holding services under a tree. They were moved to help the church acquire a plot for a tabernacle for worship. Thanks for praying. Keep praying that God will also provide for the building. Praise the Lord.

SRBBC: They are in the process of divesting the college courses and adding training in other employable skills, such as Nursing Training, Computer Science, Education, and others. They are also approaching the accreditation body responsible for Tertiary institutions to seek accreditation for the college, so that the diplomas and certificates they issue here will be recognized worldwide.

It has become necessary to pursue this path because young men who are interested in serving the Lord are reluctant to attend a college whose certificates are not recognized. Expanding the programs with accreditation will also attract more students and help the college become a self-supporting institution. A preliminary inspection has been conducted, and recommendations have been made, including completing the second floor of the Multipurpose building, which currently houses the library and the administration block. Our library will install internet access and add computers so students are not limited to the library's books and can go online to do research.

An Information Communication Technology (I.C.T) Center is to be set up to enhance training in Computer Science and Information Technology.

FUNDAMENTAL BAPTIST MISSION, IVORY COAST:

Bible Institute

The Bible school is progressing, having just accomplished a three-year training program leading to the baccalaureate. Dr. Seth Mohenu was at the ceremony. The current group of students would like to study to the doctoral level.

The school will seek guidance from Dr. Tom Wolfe (IPM Education Department) regarding the program in Ghana. The next academic year in Côte d'Ivoire begins March, 2026.

The Deaf Ministry:

The deaf ministry is grateful for the one-hectare plot of land purchased. Plans are afoot to build a vocational training school for the deaf as well as a church building. Thanks to all who gave. New sign language classes involving twenty-two people are offered every Sunday evening.

ETHIOPIA:

A new couple has joined the church. They have two sons, with the older showing spiritual fruit. The Saturday youth meeting is growing. A university student has joined.
