We are grateful to God Almighty for counting us worthy to serve as under-shepherds in the propagation of the Gospel to a perishing world. We are also deeply thankful to you for empowering us to reach others with the Good News of Jesus Christ through your prayers and support.

We continue ministering daily because Christ has sent us and you have helped send us. As the Apostle Paul wrote in Epistle to the Romans 10:15, "How shall they preach, except they be sent?"

By His grace this quarter, I conducted:

- Three wedding ceremonies
- Two funeral services
- Two baptism services
- One couples' retreat

During our outreach efforts:

- 22 people received Christ.
- 43 people accepted Christ at our annual conference.
- Additionally, four individuals were baptized.

All these were accomplished through your prayers and faithful support!

**Prayer Requests:**

1. **Vehicle Need:** We thank the Lord for His protection as we serve in difficult and sometimes dangerous areas. However, we kindly ask you to remember us in prayer regarding our transportation needs. Each time we travel, I am concerned about possible breakdowns due to the poor condition of our current vehicle. We are trusting the Lord to provide a reliable pickup truck for multipurpose ministry use.
2. **Church / Outreach Ministry:** We praise the Lord for preparing hearts wherever He sends us. Although there are more than one hundred churches in our city, only a few consistently preach salvation messages; many focus mainly on prosperity teachings.
3. Beloved, kindly remember **our Evangelists**. At present, we have six men who are faithfully carrying the gospel to villages and towns. At least \$150 to \$250 per month would help to sustain an Evangelist. Please, pray with them.
4. **Children's Ministry:** Thank God for the Children's Ministry, which continues to grow each week. Sister Joan and her team faithfully reach out to children in the community. They host a mini party every last Saturday of the month as an outreach tool. This quarter, 100 children professed Christ as Lord and Savior. Please pray that their love for Christ will grow and that they will become strong disciples.
5. **Youth Camp (July 21–25, 2026):** After many years without a youth camp, we are praying for the Lord's provision to host one this year. We are expecting about 40 young people to attend. Total projected cost: \$2,600.00 (Transportation: \$300; Food: \$600; Lodging:



\$1,700) Locally, we aim to raise \$800 and are trusting the Lord for the remaining \$1,800. Please pray with us for God's provision and for transformed lives during this camp.

6. **Deaf Ministry:** We praise God for His goodness in the Deaf Ministry. Sunday attendance continues to increase gradually. Pastor Japheth conducts Bible studies for deaf teachers, focusing on sound Bible doctrine, as many of them previously attended secular rather than Christian institutions. They are responding well and encouraging others to join. During vacation periods, many of the deaf members travel to relatives to seek support for personal needs. Unfortunately, two of our teachers were recently attacked in separate incidents: Tayatou Zopue was assaulted, and a harmful chemical was thrown on his face, causing severe injury. He underwent surgery and spent many days hospitalized. A few days later, Rudolph Dehmie was attacked and beaten by thieves, who stole his cash and personal belongings. Please pray for their full recovery, protection, and encouragement.

7. **Home Church - Repentance Baptist Church:** Repentance Baptist Church is my home church. It was in this church building that I accepted Christ in 1975, when my uncle, Pastor Cooper Troy, led me to the Lord. The old church building has become severely dilapidated and unsafe. Six years ago, we began constructing a new building, but progress has been slow due to limited attendance and financial challenges. We are specifically praying for support to complete the flooring and ceiling work.

8. **Christian Foundation School:** Enrollment for the 2025/2026 academic year has been lower than expected. We currently have 380 students and 36 staff members. Our target was 450 students, which would have better supported the annual budget. Despite the challenges, we rejoice that 20 students from diverse backgrounds have accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as their personal Savior.
